January

Tues. Jan. 01: Nigeria – *Happy New Year and a Very Christ-Centred 2019!* Thank God for His love, mercy and faithfulness upon Nigeria and exalt Him for making us partakers of this New Year. Ask Him to thwart every scheme of the enemy concerning this country especially towards the forth-coming elections and pray that only His counsel will prevail. Plead with God to give us leaders after His own heart with precepts to uphold righteousness and justice for His namesake.

Wed. Jan. 02: Independent National Electoral Commission (INEC) – Pray that God's counsel and awe will overshadow the Chairman and officials of INEC to conduct free and fair elections this year 2019 and subsequently. Pray that honesty and justice would be demonstrated all through the elections with every vote counting. Ask God to take absolute control of the elections.

Thurs. Jan. 03: Mauritania – Praise God for the few Christians located in Mauritania; pray that they will clearly demonstrate the love of Christ. Ask God to endue them with courage, wisdom and protection, as they become powerful witnesses for Jesus Christ in Mauritania. Pray that seekers might encounter Jesus and be courageous to follow Him. Continue to pray for freedom of religion socially and legally in the land.

Fri. Jan. 04: Burundi – Thank God for the groups in Burundi that distinguish themselves by their admirable holistic approach to ministry. Pray that the powerful and loving Spirit of God will overrule the spirits of enmity and vengeance and pray for the lasting positive changes that only the gospel of Christ can bring to the land. Ask God to send more passionate labourers that will render holistic ministry to the needy and neglected rural areas of Burundi.

Sat, Jan. 05: French Mayotte, Southeast Africa – Pray for a spiritual breakthrough and miraculous harvest among the Muslim majority in Mayotte. Ask God to endue the few Christians in the land with an mindset/strategy of evangelism that is biblical and culturally appropriate to enable them reach out to the people and to properly disciple them. Ask God to raise long-term missionaries for this nation.

Sun, Jan. 6: Burkina-Faso – Thank God for a significant minority of converts from other religions. Ask God overturn the strong presence of false religions in Burkina-Faso and pray for the missionary reinforcement needed in a wide range of ministries. Also, ask God to stir a strong grassroots movement to be top of churches agenda and demonstrate His saving power among the unreached in the land.

Mon. Jan. 07: Mali – Thank God for the emergence of second generation Christians in Mali and pray that He would use them greatly to expand His Kingdom in the land. Ask God to intervene in the poverty situation of the country and to release the people from physical and spiritual bondage of false religions (they use financial and material aids to tie the people to false gods). Pray that Malians would hear, read about and experience Jesus and His salvation.

Tues. Jan. 08: Ethiopia – Thank God for the move of Holy Spirit that brought long needed unity to body of Christ in the land; pray against whatever would try to frustrate the new found unity. Pray that the Holy Spirit will revitalise the biblical heritage and spiritual legacy of the ancient Ethiopian Church. Pray that the body of Christ will hate evil and make discipleship a top priority, especially for the younger generation.

Wed. Jan. 09: China – Thank God for the preservation and growth of the Church in China. Pray that followers of Christ will become more devoted disciples, firmly planted in the truth of Scripture and growing in the faith. The need for Bibles and other Christian materials are enormous in China; ask God to flourish the ministry of Bible translators and the production of Christian literature to meet up with the demand.

Thurs. Jan. 10: Saudi Arabia – Pray fervently for the protection and steadfastness of the few believers among the Arabs of Saudi and for wisdom and courage as they grow in faith. Ask God to encounter their leaders and use the religious zeal as He did with Saul of Tarsus (Acts 9:15). Pray against the official blocking and monitoring of Internet traffic so that people will have access to various Christian websites in Saudi.

Fri. Jan. 11: India – Thank God for making the Christians in India more aware of their constitutional rights. Ask God to give them courage and resoluteness to remain faithful and not choose the world with its fleeting promises and pleasures. Pray that the Church in India will develop burden for the teens and youths; ask God to grant the missionaries and ministers the right strategy and method to communicate the Gospel to them.

Sat. Jan. 12: Palestine – Pray for grace, boldness and wisdom for the few Palestine Christians being attacked or betrayed from all sides by Muslims and Israelites and also feel abandoned by the global Church. Pray for the fulfilment of God's purpose in Palestine that the Jewish Israeli and Palestine Arab would meet the Prince of Peace. Pray fervently and enthrone Jesus Christ, Lord over the city of Jerusalem.

Sun. Jan. 13. Malaysia – Pray for a viable Christian congregations of ethnic Malays that would be able to reach out to their people both at home and abroad. Also, pray that the Christians in Malaysia will be courageous and faithful to share the Gospel despite huge legal and social barriers. Pray that expatriate Christian workers with adequate funds will receive necessary visas and extensions and serve effectively within the limited time.

Mon. Jan. 14: Kazakhstan – Thank God for what He is doing in this country as the Church continues to grow numerically and spiritually. Ask God to raise passionate and sacrificial missionaries that will identify with the people and be ready to take the good news to them in their language. Pray that believers will remain united and faithful to the truth despite severe oppositions and growing diversity of theology.

Tues. Jan. 15: Brunei – Here conversion to another religion is illegal; pray to nullify this law. Also pray for an atmosphere and constitution that will allow freedom of religion and worship in Brunei. Ask God to grant the Christians unity, perseverance and boldness to stand firm in the face of all forms of opposition and continue to pray for numerical and spiritual growth despite the restrictions in the land.

Wed. Jan. 16: 10/40 Window – Pray that the few believers located in this geographical and spiritual area will see the need and realise the urgency for them to spread the good news of our Lord Jesus Christ to the numerous unreached people groups at their doorstep and environment. By the power of the Holy Spirit pull down the strongholds in the 10/40 window and declare Jesus Christ, Lord over the region.

Thurs. Jan. 17: Nigeria Evangelical Missions Association (NEMA) – Thank God for what He is using NEMA to achieve. Ask the Lord to grant grace, inspiration, wisdom and guidance to the leadership of **Nigeria Evangelical Missionary Institute (NEMI)** the training arm of NEMA and to make financial resources available for the school. Pray that the students will continue to complete their training successfully.

Fri. Jan. 18: Abuja – Thank God for the indigenous tribes in the Federal Capital Territory (FCT). Pray that God will burden the churches and other Christian organisations located in the FCT to reach out to the unreached peoples within their reach. Pray for revival and commitment among the Christians in Abuja to be focused on Christ amid their busy schedules.

Sat. Jan. 19: The Bashar (Yankam), Plateau State – Pray that God will heal the hearts of the people and remove hatred and hostility towards Christianity from them. Also, pray that Christians around the Bashar people will deliberately reach out to them with the Gospel and the love of Christ. Pray and destroy the forces that hinder the Gospel in Bashar land.

Sun. Jan. 20: Becheeve People, Cross Rivers State – Pray God to deliver the girls from this community from the bondage of “money marriage”; whereby a very young girl is given out in marriage for a debt as low as three thousand naira (N3,000). They could therefore, go into slavery and prostitution to enable her feed the so-called husbands’ entire family (his legal wife and children).

Mon. Jan. 21: The Bisa/Busa, Kebbi State – Pray that the people of Bisa will become dissatisfied with the false religions they adhere to and begin to seek Jesus Christ (the Truth and the Way) so that they may have peace and eternal life. Ask God to send more labourers with burden for the Bisa people and to open their hearts to receive and accept the good news of Jesus Christ.

Tues. Jan. 22: The Gurmana, Niger State – Pray against the spirit of fear and persecution hindering the people from accepting the Lordship of Jesus Christ. Ask God to raise passionate missionaries for the land of Gurmana and for Jesus to reveal Himself to their leaders, influencers and family heads to enable mass repentance and the birthing of the Church in the land.

Wed. Jan. 23: The Bolewa, Yobe State – Pray that the Christians living among the Bolewa people will portray the life of Christ. Ask God to do a cleansing in the hearts and minds of the people for them to understand and accept the Gospel of Truth and grant the missionaries the best approach to reach out to the people. Pray for fruitfulness in the land of Bolewa.

Thurs. Jan. 24: Mission Mobilisers – Thank God for safe trips and good success He has been granting every mission mobiliser across the globe. Ask Him to open up churches for collaboration to achieve His purpose for humanity and pray that the Lord will continue to sustain, direct and protect them as they serve Him.

Fri. Jan. 25: Missionaries/Ministers' Children – Pray that parents would meet up with the Master's expectation of them concerning these Children — children of good reputation. Stand against whatever will hinder them from living for Christ and being role models in their generation. Continue to pray for their sustenance and fruitfulness in all their pursuits.

Sat. Jan. 26: Missions Supporters League (MSL) International Office – Pray that the International Director (ID) will continue to hear the voice of God clearly and to maintain intimacy with Jesus Christ as he pilots the affairs of MSL. Pray for safety, resources and success as he embarks on several trips in the cause of God's mandate.

Sun. Jan. 27: Missions Supporters League (MSL), Kenya Office – Thank the Lord for His faithfulness over all staff in the office and ask Him to raise every support they need to facilitate their work leading to the salvation of nations. Pray that His servants in Kenya will remain steadfast and faithful unto Him and the work He has committed into their care.

Mon. Jan. 28: MSL Nigeria Board and National Council – Thank God for the contributions and labour of these members in ensuring that the Great Commission is accomplished through the platform of MSL. Pray for God’s protection, guidance and sustenance for them and for grace and wisdom to continue to provide godly leadership and counsel for the Ministry.

Tues. Jan. 29: MSL Chapters and Partners – Pray that the Chapter members and partners of MSL will remain fervent in prayer and committed to their duties in the Great Commission. Ask God to bless them abundantly in all their endeavours as they pursue His cause. Pray for God’s guidance, safety and sustenance for their family members and that they remain in His agenda.

Wed. Jan. 30: MSL Staff/Missionaries – Thank God for the gift of life for all MSL staff who function as missionaries. Also, thank Him for His love, goodness and mercies that they experience in different dimensions in their walk and work with God. Pray that He will continue to provide for them and make them more dedicated and focused with sacrificial and selfless hearts as they serve Him.

Thurs. Jan. 31: The Universal Church – Pray that the Universal Church will indeed be of one body (the Body of Christ) rooted in one Foundation. Pray that Christians will use their spiritual gifts, talents and resources for the edification of the Church and propagation of the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ. Pray that the Church will continue to move on in the face of persecution, trials and temptation.

February

Fri. Feb. 01: Nigeria – Thank and praise God for our nation Nigeria. Pray that God will continue to sustain the country and to frustrate every evil plan concerning her. Pray that the Lordship of Jesus Christ will continue to rule over the affairs of this nation despite the plans of the devil and his cohorts. Ask God to give us leaders that will glorify His name in this nation.

Sat. Feb. 02: Somalia – Continue to pray for healing for the people and the land of Somalia. Ask God to encounter the warlords, pirates and the aggressive Islamist groups that have traumatised the nation with wars and violence. Pray God to erase the false notions about Christianity being associated with the Western decadence and every prejudice against the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

Sun. Feb. 03: Senegal – Ask God to prepare labourers that will intentionally reach out to the approximately 75,000 deaf Muslims in Senegal. Pray that this special group of people will experience the supernatural love and peace found only in our Saviour Jesus Christ. Pray God to meet their needs accordingly.

Mon. Feb. 04: Cameroon – Pray that God would raise witnesses for Himself among the unreached people groups in Cameroon. Ask the Lord to equip and send to Cameroon the pioneer missionaries needed for Bible translation ministry and reach out to Muslim and animist northern peoples. Pray for the availability of Scriptures in the indigenous heart-languages of the people.

Tues. Feb. 05: Eritrea – Thank God for the strong growth of the Church in Eritrea despite the closure of most denominations and ministries, and targeted opposition from the government. Ask God to shower His peace upon the land and pray for open doors so that Christian workers can return to the country. Pray that those with access will maximise the opportunity to effectively demonstrate the love of God in Eritrea.

Wed. Feb. 06: Sierra Leone – Thank God for the Christian organisations actively involved in the rebuilding of the country and ministering holistically to the needs of the people. Ask God to raise labourers that will reach out to the former child soldiers that they may have wholesome lives again. Ask God to grant the Christians wisdom, boldness and clarity as they reach out to the Muslims in love and humility.

Thurs. Feb. 07: Tunisia – Only one-third of approximately 500 indigenous believers in Tunisia meet regularly for worship and fellowship. Pray that a living and growing Church will become a reality again in this nation that once experienced the love of Christ. Pray for protection and steadfastness for the few Tunisian believers who have remained faithful for more than a decade.

Fri. Feb. 08: Africa – Pray against the non-Christian customs and worldviews that permeate the Church of Christ in Africa. Pray that the Church will place a high priority on discipleship, which is lacking. Pray for unity of spirit and purpose and that church leaders will place their personal fame and agendas at the foot of the cross of Jesus Christ.

Sat. Feb. 09: Europe – Pray that Europeans will regain confidence in the Scripture and in the uniqueness of the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ. Ask God to bestow wisdom, passion and biblical understanding upon the emerging Church movements operating from a missional platform. Pray that their efforts will have a renewing and redemptive impact on the Church and society respectively.

Sun. Feb. 10: Pacific Region – Thank God for the efforts churches in the Pacific Region are making to renew their mission vision in the region. Ask God to pull them out of their comfort zones and to teach them to minister cross-culturally and in the context of economic needs of the people. Pray that God would move in dynamic and effective ways in the region.

Mon. Feb. 11: The Arabs – Thank for the few Arabs that are Christians and pray that God will continue to sustain them; granting them grace and boldness in the face of persecution and oppositions. Pray that Christ will continue to reveal Himself to the Arabs especially their leaders despite their locations and that they would become dissatisfied with false religions.

Tues. Feb. 12: Asia – Thank God for the remarkable growth of the Church of Christ among the Asian nations. Ask God to break the strongholds of the nations that persecute Christians and restrict religious freedom. Pray that the few believers among them will remain steadfast and that indigenous Christians will continue to emerge and multiply in this region of the world.

Wed. Feb. 13: America – Pray for effective and viable policies to combat the evil in America and that God will end the seemingly insatiable appetite that fuels the evil. Pray for sanctification and maturity for Christians in America and pull down the strongholds of false teachings and mammon in the Church. Ask Christ to shine His light upon America as a nation that they may find satisfaction in Him.

Thurs. Feb. 14: Nigeria Evangelical Missions Association (NEMA) – Pray that God will continue to guide the leadership of NEMA in all ramifications and ask Him to raise faithful stewards to collaborate with them in the area of providing resources to facilitate the work of Missions in their domain.

Fri. Feb. 15: El-Rehoboth (M2414) – Pray for God's presence, guidance and protection for the Board and staff members of El-Rehoboth Ministry. Pray that they remain focused and that God will continue to use them in various ways to fulfil the Great Commission.

Sat. Feb. 16: The Iku People, Kaduna State – There is no agency or Christian group targeting the Iku people. Pray for intercessors and missionaries who will volunteer to reach out to them with prayers and the good news of our Lord Jesus Christ. Ask God to enable penetration of the Gospel among this people group and do that which only Him can do to glorify himself in the land of Iku.

Sun. Feb. 17: The Boko-Baru, Kwara State – Pray against persecution and oppositions that hinder the people from accepting the Lordship of Jesus Christ. Ask the Lord to enable the churches in the land to have a breakthrough among the Boko-Baru people. Pray for passionate and selfless missionaries that will live among the people.

Mon. Feb. 18: The Fulani – Thank God for the Fulani believers globally and pray that He will continue to sustain and direct them in all their ways. Ask God to raise a triumphant Fulani Church in Nigeria to the glory of His name. Pray that the unsaved Fulani people especially their key leaders will begin to have a revelation of Jesus Christ in undeniable and irresistible ways.

Tues. Feb. 19: The Duwai People, Yobe State – Thank God for the believers among this group of people and pray that they remain focused and faithful even in difficult situations. Pray that Christians living among them will be bold to preach the good news to them and that God will make possible the production of the Scriptures available in any format for them to access.

Wed. Feb. 20: The Eloyi People, Benue and Plateau States – Pray that God will enable the indigenous Eloyi believers to share the gospel of Jesus Christ to their people and that the Lord would reveal Himself to them, especially to leaders and family heads. Ask God to grant the missionaries working among the Eloyi all that they need to reach out to them effectively and bless their labour with a victorious indigenous Church.

Thurs. Feb. 21: The Dong People, Adamawa State – Ask God to raise intercessors that will break through the land of Dong with prayers and to pull down the stronghold of traditional religion among the people. Pray for the availability of the Gospel in any format in this people's heart language, e.g. Jesus film and radio broadcast, and ask God to raise and equip labourers that will reach out to them.

Fri. Feb. 22: Missions Supporters League (MSL) International Office – Thank God for open doors of ministry in various countries. Pray for the successful establishment of MSL national movements in those areas and pray for renewed grace, wisdom and knowledge for the International Director as he coordinates this aspect of our operations.

Sat. Feb. 23: MSL Chapters – Ask God to bless the efforts of Chapters and committed members who take missions support as a task across the nation. Also ask Him to create effective access/open doors to the churches and individuals with vision and burden for missions in various zones especially in the Southern region. Pray that He will sustain and guide MSL Chapter members within and outside Nigeria.

Sun. Feb. 24: MSL Partners and Friends – Thank God for the good and faithful partners and friends He has blessed MSL with. Ask God to draw them closer to Jesus Christ especially in these trying times and pray that He will continue to sustain and prosper them in all their endeavours. Pray that they will not lose hope but continue to wax stronger especially in their relationship with the Lord.

Mon. Feb. 25: Missions Supporters League (MSL) Nigeria, National Office – Continue to thank God for the sustenance and safety of the missionaries in the National Office. Pray that He will remain our guide and fortress while we stay focused and committed unto the end. Missions is capital intensive, so ask God to raise consistent and committed financial and material supporters for the Ministry within and outside Nigeria.

Tues. Feb. 26: Bible Translators – Thank God for the efforts of the Bible Translators globally. Pray that God will continue to protect, sustain and equip them to make the Scriptures accessible, handy and available in various unreached people groups' languages. Pray that the Bible will continue to get to those who earnestly and diligently seek it despite opposition.

Wed. Feb. 27: Youths Globally – Pray that God will cause a massive revival among students in schools and campuses that would make youths to surrender their lives to Jesus Christ and to respond accordingly to missions. Pray also that the body of Christ universally would seize the opportunities the envisaged revival will present to properly disciple the new converts.

Thurs. Feb. 28: Nigerian Church – Extreme denominationalism is a major challenge facing the Church in Nigeria currently. Pray that the Church in Nigeria will unite and work together in love and harmony to meet the demand of God concerning the Great Commission. Pray that Christians in Nigeria will desire a closer walk with God and greater commitment for in order to be more useful to the Kingdom of God.

March

Fri. March 01: GO International: Praise God for the work of this ministry among the Unreached People groups within and outside Nigeria. Pray that the Lord will continually strengthen all their leaders and missionaries so that they can stay focused on the task of reaching the nations with the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Sat. March 02: Madagascar – Promises of prosperity lure the poor away from their congregations to another causing feud among Church leaders. Pray for greater unity of spirit and purpose among churches and leaders in the country and ask the Holy Spirit to help believers overcome pride and jealousy with humility and Kingdom consciousness. Also ask God to bless the efforts of missionaries serving in this Island.

Sun. March 03: The Gambia – The Gambian Church needs greater motivation and ambition to reach out to the unreached peoples in the country directly. Pray for enablement and grace for the Church to reach out and for Christians to take advantage of the religious freedom to share and demonstrate the gospel of Jesus Christ to all peoples of The Gambia. Pray also that nominal Christians will discover the real life in Christ Jesus.

Mon. March 04: Egypt – A number of Christians have suffered and some even died for their faith in Egypt; pray that Christians will be steadfast and live exemplary lives before their oppressors in times of mistreatment. Pray for grace, wisdom and courage for the Church leaders to handle the Muslim authorities and all forms of persecution. Pray also for a closer walk with God for the leaders to be good examples to their flock.

Tues. March 05: Algeria – The whole nation is virtually unreached. Pray that the few Christians that make up the Church in Algeria will respond to pressures and persecution from all angles with faith and perseverance. Pray for the young girls who are forced to conceal their faith and marry Muslims and ask God for grace, enablement and endurance for the few Christian couples as they minister to the Church.

Wed. March 06: Mozambique, Eastern Africa – Mozambique houses the largest number of unreached peoples in Eastern Africa and remains one of the world's poorest nations. Pray for labourers who will be willing to sacrifice and persevere under hard conditions in order to share the good news of Jesus to the unreached peoples of Mozambique. Pray also that the new converts will become solid disciples as they establish biblical churches.

Thurs. March 07: Libya – Most of the believers are migrants; pray that they will have spiritual influence on Libyans and their fellow migrants and that the nationals will give heed to the Gospel. Pray also that the few Libyan believers will remain faithful in the face of pressures and oppositions from their families and society. Bibles and other Christian materials in Libyan Arabic are of great need to enable the people read and hear the Gospel in their heart language.

Fri. March 08: Togo – The export of unprotected orphans and poor children, especially girls under 19 years still flourishes in the land; pray that this illegal trade of child trafficking will end. The stream of conversions to Islam is fast and stable with just a few Christian workers reaching out to the high concentrations of Muslims in the land. Pray the Lord of harvest to thrust out labourers into the land of Togo.

Sat. March 09: Hong Kong – The Christian community in Hong Kong has some influential role in serving society in hospitals, schools and social organisations. Pray that the Church will continue to be salt and light in these places, thereby transforming the people and the society. Pray against the forces of their numerous temples and shrines that oppose the Lordship of Jesus Christ over the land of Hong Kong.

Sun. March 10: Bangladesh – God is moving in mysterious ways, performing His wonders in Bangladesh; praise Him! Pray that the Spirit of God will subdue the forces of darkness operating in the religious, social and ethnic realms. Pray for open doors for projects and training programmes to strengthen the Bangladeshi Church, as they need them to effectively reach out.

Mon. March 11: Turkey – Thank God for the influence and developing role of European Union (EU) as a regional diplomatic force, this seems to create a little opportunity to spread the Gospel in Turkey. Pray against the deep-seated general resistance to everything that has to do with Christianity, which makes evangelism difficult. Pray for favourable change in public attitudes, especially the Press towards Christianity in the country.

Tues. March 12: Bosnia in Europe – Bosnia is generally not receptive to the Gospel. Pray that many might hear and accept the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ. Bosnian Muslims are among the least evangelised people in Europe. Pray against the strong activities of Islam that hinder the spread of the Gospel in the land and ask God to dry up their resources used for these anti-Gospel activities.

Wed. March 13: Haiti – Pray and subject the spirit of voodoo to the authority of Jesus Christ, especially in the lives Christians. Pray that Christians will develop an intimate relationship with Christ that will transform them to overcome the heritage and spirit of voodoo. Having experienced so much set back, pray for the outpouring of the Holy Spirit and for godly leaders for the nation of Haiti.

Thurs. March 14: Dominica (Caribbean) – There is no trace of evangelical witness in about 4,000 villages in Dominica, meaning nobody has for once engaged them with the Gospel. Pray that the light and love of our Lord Jesus will penetrate into the land and hearts of people and pray for labourers who will intentionally and willingly serve among them. Pray for favour and open doors as labourers prepare to engage the people.

Fri. March 15: Iran – The few churches that meet publicly, observe the government law of never to evangelise Muslims overtly, yet the Church of Christ keeps growing in all forms in Iran. Pray that the body of Christ will continue to multiply and mature despite opposition and persecution. Pray for protection, adequate income and fortitude for all the Christians in the land as they remain committed.

Sat. March 16: Nigeria Evangelical Missionary Institute (NEMI) – Pray that the training institute will become a focal point in training for Cross-cultural ministry and in facilitating leadership empowerment and human development of member agencies nation wide. Pray for the provision of all they need to remain efficient and effective in God's agenda for the Great Commission.

Sun. March 17: Christian Missionary Foundation (CMF)-Baruba Field – Pray that God will use the School run by CMF in Baruba to develop work force that would in turn reach out to the entire community and beyond with the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ. Pray for God’s continuous protection, wisdom and sustenance for missionaries serving among the Baruba people in Kwara State.

Mon. March 18: Calvary International Ministries – Thank God for the efforts of the Calvary International Ministries in fulfilling the mandate of God. Pray that both the leaders and staff members will remain focused and efficient in Ministry. Also, pray for God’s protection and provision of resources for effective ministry and for tangible fruits in their various fields.

Tues. March 19: Go International-Bankalewa Field – Missions and evangelism in regions like this are usually very challenging. Ask God to endow the missionaries in this field with all that they need to remain focused and committed in service. Pray that they remain sensitive to the leading of the Holy Spirit and for their safety.

Wed. March 20: Nigeria Fellowship of Evangelical Students (NIFES) – Appreciate God for the efforts of NIFES in reaching out to students on various campuses with the Gospel. Using her as a point of contact to other students’ ministries, ask God to endue them with more grace and wisdom to reach out to students on various campuses across the nation more effectively with the Gospel.

Thurs. March 21: CAPRO-Gerawa Field – Ask the Holy Spirit to lead the missionaries in this field as they carry out their activities this year and pray God to bless their efforts in the land of Gerawa with fruitfulness. Pray for joy and fulfilment as they serve the Lord among this people group in Bauchi State.

Fri. March 22: Cave Missions-Ura/Urawa Field – Ask God to stir up the few Christians in this community to pray and reach out to the Urawa people with the gospel of Jesus Christ. Pray against the spread of other religions and ask God to open the eyes of the people to the deceits of these religions. Pray for the revelation Jesus Christ as the Son of God to the key leaders of Ura land.

Sat. March 23: Omega2 Project of Four Square Church Asokoro – Thank God for the efforts of Four Square Church Asokoro in mission activities. Pray that their leaders will never loose sight of the vision and the Commission. Pray also that God will continue to use the project to see that missionaries are truly supported, equipped and empowered to bring in the harvest.

Sun. March 24: Christian Workers – Thank for the efforts of Christians workers globally. Pray that everyone will remain focused and faithful to that which the Lord has committed into his/her hand to do in relation to the Great Commission. Continue to pray for God's grace, sustenance and courage not to compromise in the face of all forms of persecution, corruption and vices.

Mon. March 25: Moslem Background Believers (MBBs) – Pray for protection, grace, sustenance and focus for this group of people as they continue to wax stronger in faith and the knowledge of the Lord Jesus Christ. Pray for strength to overcome obstacles that might come their ways and for courage for them to relate the good news in love to their own people who have not yet believed and are persecuting them.

Tues. March 26: Missions Supporters League (MSL) Kenya – Thank God for sustenance and the efforts of the MSL team in Kenya. Pray for grace, wisdom and guidance as the team strives to mobilise more Christians and churches in that region to get involved in the Great Commission. Pray that their efforts will yield abiding fruits that would propagate the gospel of Jesus Christ in East Africa and beyond.

Wed. March 27: MSL New Frontiers – Thank God for what He is doing in lives of youths through this platform. Ask God to raise and groom more youths who are passionate about His Kingdom through the New Frontiers activities and use them to fulfil His purpose in this nation and beyond. Pray for God's grace, favour, safety and sustenance for the Youth Mobilisation Officer as he anchors this arm of the Ministry.

Thurs. March 28: MSL National/International Offices – Pray that every missionary serving with MSL will continue to abide in Jesus Christ, serving wholeheartedly as unto Him and not be found wanting. Continue to pray for their protection and sustenance in all areas of their lives and ministries. Pray for more grace and guidance for the leaders and ask God to provide the needed resources to facilitate MSL operations and services.

Fri. March 29: Mission Mobilisation – Pray for mission mobilisation efforts in Nigeria and around the globe by mission organisations such as CAPRO, NEMA, MSL, Go International just to mention a few with their Chapters. Ask the Lord to unveil new and creative ways of mission mobilization to the leaders and members. Pray that God will also bless their efforts and endow them with the grace, wisdom and courage commensurate to task.

Sat. March 30: Students' Ministry in Nigeria – Pray for grace, love and unity between students and Christian Ministries reaching out to the students in Nigeria. Pray that Ministries, Organisations and denominations will reach out to students passionately and effectively with the Truth and Light of Jesus Christ. Earnestly pray that these students would embrace and enjoy the real life that is in Christ Jesus.

Sun. March 31: Universal Church – Pray against the attitudes of Christians going to church for the material things they can gain or receive (“parasitic” and “consumeristic” attitudes). Pray that the Church will be a place for fellowship and edification of one another and for spiritual leaders to develop effective methods and structures for discipleship. Plead with God to revive His Church so that she occupy effectively for Him.

April

Mon. April 01: Nigeria – Using Psalm 112: 6 &7, continue to pray for the peace and wellbeing of Nigeria and Nigerians. Pray that the spiritual and political leaders will lay all their ambitions and agendas aside by the authority that is in Christ Jesus. Enthroned Jesus Christ in every sphere and part of Nigeria, dethroning all forms of bad governance, greed and evil.

Tues. April 02: Sudan – Sudan is a difficult place for Christians to live. Thank God for the population of Christians in the land and pray for grace, protection and sustenance for believers. Pray that the power of the gospel of Jesus Christ will destroy all the forces that resist and hinder it from spreading through the land of Sudan. Also, pray for courage and enablement for the missionaries serving there to be effective in their work.

Wed. April 03: Kenya – Pray for unreached places/groups like Khoisan, Mijikenda, coastal Swahili and the Arab population in Kenya that God will open their hearts to receive the salvation message and accept Jesus Christ as their Saviour and Lord. Pray also for those labouring in this land that God will grant them the grace and courage to focus on their calling despite oppositions and distractions.

Thurs. April 04: Angola – Biblical faith is a great challenge to the Church in Angola; explosive growth is worthless if the Church is permeated with false beliefs and ignorance of the Bible and lacks spiritual maturity. Ask God to develop Christian leaders who will teach the Church the life and ways of Christ. Pray that Christians in Angola would be like Jesus Christ and reach out to their numerous unbelieving neighbours who are apathetic and disillusioned.

Fri. April 05: Morocco – Pray that the power of the Holy Spirit will cause the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ to flourish in Morocco and saturate the land. Ask God to open the hearts of the people to heed and accept the good news of the Gospel. Ask God to endow those reaching out to the Moroccans at home and abroad with all that they need to function effectively. May the Kingdom of Jesus Christ be established in the land of Morocco!

Sat. April 06: Gabon – Pray against the strongholds of the beliefs and practices of worship of ancestral spirits and other religions (syncretism), deeply pervasive and widely observed even among the churches in Gabon. Pray that Christians will understand the Bible and practice what it teaches them so that they can effectively evangelise the massive and growing number of Muslims. Ask God to revive the steadily waning power of the Church of Christ in the land of Gabon.

Sun. April 07: Darfur Region of Sudan – The group of people in this region, despite their strong Islamic background and being overwhelmingly Muslim in composition now face horrific oppression by government-sponsored militia. Pray that this challenge will cause them to start seeking for the Truth that will lead them to Jesus Christ who alone can liberate and give them peace with eternal life.

Mon. April 08: Mauritius – Pray against the rule and culture of Hindu and strong ancestral and ethnic ties that seriously oppose the spread of the Gospel in this land. Pray also against nominalism and numerical decline in the churches. Ask the Lord to stir up a revival and for spiritual vitality among the churches in the land. Pray for provision and distribution of the right Christian materials and for God to equip and thrust missionaries into this nation.

Tues. April 09: Belgium – Lack of indigenous spiritual leaders is a serious challenge that is crippling discipleship among indigenous believers and spiritual growth among the churches in the land. Also, most of the few Christian workers and pastors are bi-vocational, which undermines the effectiveness of the first generation believers. Pray in this light especially for leaders with godly qualities to mentor and guide the Church in God's direction. Pray also for the completion of the Bible Institute in Belgium.

Wed. April 10: Estonia Northern Europe – Pray God to burden and thrust missionaries into this unreached land, which is ready for harvest. Pray for wise and upright leadership that would model righteousness and biblical values in the country. Pray fervently that the Lord will establish His truth and light in the Republic of Estonia and that Estonians would follow Jesus Christ in a meaningful way.

Thurs. April 11: China – Thank God for a rapidly growing and spreading Church in China. Pray for the availability of God's Word to all who seek it and for the provision of Chinese Bibles urgently needed. Ask God to inspire and equip the believers and missionaries for the task of drug rehabilitation, marital counselling and suicide prevention in the nation.

Fri. April 12: Vietnam – Thank God for the Church that is emerging from persecution and for the Vietnamese converts efforts to reach out to their own people within and outside. Pray that they will proclaim the gospel clearly and effectively, particularly among the growing number of young professionals. Continue to pray for those imprisoned because of their faith in Christ.

Sat. April 13: Bihar, State of India – This is the poorest and second most populated State in India and Christianity is 0.3%. Ask God to shine the saving, liberating and sustaining light of Jesus Christ upon the land and suffering people of Bihar. Ask the Lord to display His power and love upon this land and the people to deliver them from physical and spiritual poverty and bondage.

Sun. April 14: Sri Lanka – Thank God that the anti-conversion bill did not pass and pray that the implementation will never become a reality in this nation. Beneath the layers of other religions lie a cocktail of spirits, gods and demons; pray that the blood and name of Jesus Christ would disarm the spiritual powers and principalities that rule over the land and people of Sri Lanka.

Mon. April 15: Maldives – Most adherents of other religions in this country are foreigners and they prohibit open practice of Christianity. The nation has never allowed any form of Christian literature or mission work. Pray for protection, grace and courage for the few Christians living in this land to stay put. Pray against strongholds of pride, fear and deception for the light of the Gospel to penetrate into the land and lives of the Maldives.

Tues. April 16: Nigeria Evangelical Missions Association (NEMA) – Pray that God will continue to equip NEMA with quality information and mobilisation resources that would in turn equip spiritual leaders, churches and Christians generally for a better walk and work with God. Pray also that the leadership will remain committed in order for NEMA to meet up with her responsibility as the umbrella body of Nigerian missions.

Wed. April 17: Mission Agencies – Thank God for the efforts of mission agencies like Go International, Christian Missionary Foundation (CMF), Baptist Missions, Calvary Ministries (CAPRO), Cave Missions, Calvary International Africa, Pleroma Missions, Grace Foundation Inland Missions (GFIM) and others in accomplishing God's mandate. Please pray that God's hand will continually rest on the leaders and the staff to do the will of God. Ask the Lord to reward their efforts with abiding fruits and to grant them grace and wisdom to continue bringing in the harvest.

Thurs. April 18: Warji People, Bauchi State – Pray that the finished work of Jesus Christ will avail and manifest its liberating power of liberation among the people of Warji. Ask God to raise and equip missionaries that will effectively reach out to them with the good news of Christ. Pray that the Christians living among them will reflect Christ and that they will reach out and lead the Warji to our Saviour and Lord Jesus Christ.

Fri. April 19: Achipawa, Kebbi and Niger States – Continue to thank God and to pray for the young churches sprouting among the people and ask God to grant grace, courage and joy to the new converts in the face of persecution and opposition. Ask God to reveal His Supremacy to the overall leader of Achipawa people to make him bow before our Lord Jesus Christ. Pray against syncretism and nominalism among the new believers

Sat. April 20: Bauchi People, Niger State – Pray fervently for the release of the Bauchi people from the captivity of false religions that they may know the Truth that would set them free. Pray that the Christians living among them would not be nominal but true believers, exhibiting the gospel life to the people. Pray for the production of written Scriptures in Bauchi language so that the people can hear God in their own language.

Sun. April 21: Isawa People of Northern Nigeria – Ask the Lord to reveal Himself to Isawa people in an irresistible manner so that they will take the long awaited decision to follow Him as the Way, the Truth and the Life. Pray that God would expose the falsehood of other religions to this unreached people group that they may know that only Jesus Christ can set free from both spiritual and cultural bondages.

Mon. April 22: Kotoko People, Borno State – The Kotoko people are very proud Muslims. Pray that the Prince of peace will take over the land and that His unconditional love will cause massive salvation of souls among the people. Continue to pray for peace to reign in this region that has been devastated by crises. There is no Christian witness in the land currently. Pray that God will encounter the people in His mercy.

Tues. April 23: Kanuri People, Borno State – As we continue to pray for peace in this land, break the powers of other religions that hinder the spread and the acceptance of the Gospel among the Kanuri people in Nigeria. Different methods and strategies have been used to reach out to them but with little results. Pray for fruitfulness in soul winning among the people and for grace and enablement for the missionaries reaching out to the Kanuri across the nation.

Wed. April 24: Missionaries – Pray that the grace of God will sustain every missionary to stay at their duty posts and that they continually focus on Jesus Christ so that they accomplish the tasks committed to them by the Master. Ask God to continue to grant them victory over challenges on a daily basis.

Thurs. April 25: Missions Supporters League (MSL), International Office – God has been the Strong Anchor of the operations of the international work of the MSL. Thank Him for the successful operations of this office despite the lack workers. Pray for more fruits and open doors for the International operations of MSL and for renewed grace, wisdom and guidance for the leadership and staff.

Fri. April 26: Missions Supporters League (MSL), Chapters and Partners – Thank God for the lives of our Chapter members and partners. Ask the Lord to continue to protect and increase them in all things and pray that they will remain committed to the task of missions support. Ask God to raise more collaborators that would support this work as unto Him in total commitment until the task of the Great Commission is accomplished.

Sat. April 27: Missions Supporters League (MSL), National Office Nigeria – The National Office is in need of skilled missionaries who are willing to serve the Lord (long/short-term) in areas such as Accounting, Graphic Designing, ICT, Media, Publishing (editing and proofreading), Administration and so on. Plead with God to thrust out missionaries to serve on the platform of MSL sacrificially and passionately.

Sun. April 28: Migrants – We have massive movements of people across the globe for one reason or the other. Ask God to grant us the needed grace, wisdom and boldness to evangelise the unbelieving migrants around us and ask God to enable believing migrants to reach out to the unreached people within their reach.

Mon. April 29: Christian Homes – Pray that God will continue to protect, guide and sustain Christian homes and ask Him to thwart the wicked plans of the enemy upon marriages. Pray that couples will be selfless and love sacrificially just as Christ loves His Church. Ask God to give us homes where Christ with His love is epitomised in all aspects.

Tues. April 30: Church of Christ in Africa – Thank God for His love and faithfulness upon His Church in Africa. Using Romans 12:1&2 pray for the Church, ask the Lord to renew His Church and make her weary of conforming to the patterns of the world. Pray that the Church will become a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God alone. Ask God help the body of Christ in Africa to occupy for Jesus Christ.

May

Wed. May 01: Nigeria – The widespread violence and shedding of innocent blood in certain parts the nation may attract God’s judgment according to Hosea 4:1-3. Please, pray that perpetrators of wanton killings across the nation will encounter God and have a change of heart and for God’s mercy to triumph over judgment. Ask the Lord to frustrate the schemes of the devil and His cohorts in Nigeria.

Thurs. May 02: Guinea – Guinea is an Islamic Republic with freedom of religion. Ask God to fortify the freedom as it seems to be eroding. The number and activities of Christians shrink and dwindle due to frequent backslide of nominal Christians. Pray that God will uphold the Christians, especially the young and weak ones and pray against the forces fighting against them. Ask God to encounter and strengthen the key leaders in a remarkable manner.

Fri. May 03: Djibouti – The very few believers in Djibouti are among the Somali and Afar people groups and they are usually ostracised, persecuted or even killed for becoming Christians by family members. Pray for sustenance and grace for them to remain faithful in the face of severe persecution. Pray for unity for them; ask God to raise strong Christian leaders from among them and send more labourers to this nation.

Sat. May 04: The Sahel Region – Ask God to foil the schemes of those orchestrating evil and violence and pray for the peace and love of Christ Jesus to prevail in this region. Pray for God’s wisdom, guidance and grace for the believers to continue evangelising the unreached people groups in this area with boldness and love. Pray for protection and sustenance for the missionaries serving across the Sahel.

Sun. May 05: Southern Africa – Ask God to intervene in the tensions and potential problems of this region such as the crippling effects of HIV/AIDS, racial tensions, the cruel violence against foreigners and refugees and the growing uncertainty and instability of the region. Ask God to restore good governance and His righteousness and pray that the evangelicals will make deliberate efforts to reach out to the physically and spiritually needy in Southern Africa.

Mon. May 06: Comoros – Pray that the many disillusioned youths in this Islamic nation would have the opportunity to hear the gospel of love, peace and hope manifested in the finished work of Jesus Christ. Pray for courage for those turning to the Lord and becoming believers, ask God to endow them with wisdom and grace to remain steadfast in the hostile environment. Pray for protection, grace and sustenance for the few Comorian believers and for resources to disciple, train and equip them.

Tues. May 07: Guinea-Bissau – Thank God for the continuous receptivity of the Gospel and for the freedom of religion in the land. Ask God to raise passionate missionaries and ministers to reach out to the people, especially those in the remotest parts of Guinea-Bissau. Pray the Lord to burden the indigenous believers to reach out to their people and to dethrone every force that hinders the spread of the Gospel in the land.

Wed. May 08: Western Sahara, Africa – This region is purely Islamic with just a handful of Christians. Pray God to cause the people to bow before the throne of God and confess that Jesus Christ is Lord in this region. Pray for grace and boldness for the few believers to remain committed and to reach out to their own people. Ask God to bless the efforts of those labouring there and to raise more labourers for the task.

Thurs. May 09: Amerindians in America – Pray against church leaders' maltreatment and restrictions, economic exploitation, anti-Christians Anthropologists and a lot more factors that hinder the effective spread of Gospel among these people. Pray for justice and opportunities to train believers desiring to reach out to the Amerindians Cross-culturally.

Fri. May 10: Czech Republic-Europe – Over 70% of the people in this country are non-religious and the freedom in this land is leading to drastic spiritual decline of the few Christians. Ask God to restore the shrinking denominations so that they can retrieve their Christian heritage and manifest newness of life in Christ Jesus. Pray for serious soul-searching among the people that would cause a shift in the spiritual atmosphere in Czech Republic.

Sat. May 11: Timor Laste-Asia – This is one of the two Asian Christian countries whose birth as a nation was very traumatic. No one can consider any of 19 indigenous people groups adequately evangelised hence, many remain ignorant of the Gospel. Pray for pioneer church planters who will sacrificially see to the establishment of God's Kingdom in Timor. Pray for effective strategies to assist with the physical needs, counselling and reconciliation (total rehabilitation) of the people.

Sun. May 12: Pacific Region – Pray that the churches among the Kiwis and Aussies would utilise the indifferences to spiritual things among the majority of the unreached peoples, especially the youths as an advantage to evangelise the people. With the speedy growth of Mormonism in Polynesia, the people are massively becoming Mormons; pray that the power of the Holy Spirit will overrule the spirit of Mormon in the land and in the lives of the people.

Mon. May 13: Israeli-Arab – Pray that the Lord's will be done concerning the Israeli-Arab conflict in the Holy Land for genuine peace to reign in Israel. Majority of the few Christians are Arabs and the very few Jewish Christians are not recognised as citizens. Societal discrimination, Islamist persecution and international apathy towards their plight are really squeezing them out. Pray and pull down these forces hindering the Gospel in the nation of Israel.

Tues. May 14: Mongolia – Pray that the Mongolians will find total freedom and transformation of their lives by accepting the Lordship of Jesus Christ. Pray also that the missionaries to this people group would have a proper contextualisation of biblical truth suitable for Mongolian culture. Pray for the continuation of openness in Mongolia to facilitate and enhance the work of God.

Wed. May 15: Abu Dhabi and Dubai-United Arab Emirates (UAE) – These are the wealthiest among the emirates. Pray for a spiritual hunger for the truth found only in Jesus Christ for them to realise the futility in the trappings of wealthy lifestyle. Pray for faithfulness and effectiveness of workers in the emirates. Pray that expatriate Christians will epitomise Christ in these nations.

Thurs. May 16: Nigeria Evangelical Missions Association (NEMA) – Pray for open doors as members of NEMA seek for access into the churches across the nation for awareness on Vision 50/15, which is an effort to mobilise 50,000 believers, equip and send them to 35 carefully selected unreached nations across the globe. Ask God to materialise this vision in His way and time.

Fri. May 17: Global Community of Missions Supporters– Praise God for as many as support Christian missions, thank Him for their commitment and pray for more grace, safety and godly direction for them. Ask God to bless and flourish the work, businesses and other means of income of every mission supporter especially in this very difficult time and pray for a closer walk with God for them.

Sat. May 18: Zabramawa People, Kebbi State – Ask God to dislodge the strongholds of all false religions in the land and lives of the people. Pray against the hostility of other religions towards Christianity and for Jesus to reign in Zabramawa land. Pray for grace, patience and guidance for the missionaries working among them and ask God to bless their efforts with fruitfulness.

Sun. May 19: Jara People, Borno State – Pray that the light of Jesus Christ will shine upon the land of Jara to dispel the powers of other religions. Pray for grace for the new converts to endure the persecution that may likely follow their decision to put their faith in Christ. Pray for protection, wisdom and sustenance for those labouring among them and pray for more cross-cultural missionaries to join the labour force in this land.

Mon. May 20: Fali People, Adamawa State – Pray against the quiet and subtle advance of Islam upon this land and for more agencies and churches to target the people for the Gospel. Animist on mountains can be very aggressive; pray for grace, courage and wisdom for the few Christians among them to reach out to their own people. Pray for dedicated missionaries who will be willing to live with them on the mountains.

Tues. May 21: Ganagana People, Kogi State – Pray against the influence of the powers of Kajigi (traditional practices) and Islam upon this land and pray that the people be liberated translated into the Kingdom of light. Pray that those who have heard the Gospel would accept the Lordship of Jesus Christ and ask God to grant the missionaries among them the key/strategy to reach to the people.

Wed. May 22: Ingwai People, Niger State – Ask Jesus Christ to reveal His supremacy to the Ingwai Islamic leaders so that they would desire His salvation. There are few Ingwai believers but the spirit of drunkenness is so strong among the people; ask God to deliver the Christians from this spirit. Pray for courage and strength for the believers to be powerful witnesses of Christ to their own people.

Thurs. May 23: Bangawa/Wurawa People, Kebbi State – Stand against satanic forces in this land and loosen their grip over the lives of the people. Ask God to raise and equip passionate and sacrificial missionaries to reach the people as they wait to hear the gospel of Jesus Christ. Pray God to encounter those that desire to be Christians among them, answer the numerous questions on their hearts and dispel all the fears they have.

Fri. May 24: Missionaries' Children – Continue to pray that these children will encounter God personally, not relying on their parents' faith and pray for grace for them to overcome societal, peer and economic pressures. Ask God to place them correctly and to raise help for them wherever they are located and pray that their parents will always be there for them when necessary.

Sat. May 25: Missionaries – Pray that missionaries will continue to preach the Gospel in a biblical way devoid of offence, prejudice or bias. Pray for the power of the Holy Spirit upon the life of every missionary and the manifestation of signs and wonders in the different areas of service, especially in the mission fields. Pray that God will continue to increase the knowledge, love and faithfulness of these ones unto the Lord. Continue to pray for God's guidance, sustenance and safety for every missionary.

Mon. May 27: Missions Supporters League (MSL), Board and Council Members – Pray that God will release His grace in greater dimensions on all Board and Council members to enable them serve Him better in their various capacities on the platform of MSL and beyond. Pray also that they will be role models for Jesus Christ in their homes, offices and environment/community. Pray for God's provision and safety for them and their family members in their travels.

Tues. May 28: Families and Friends of Missions Supporters League (MSL), – Praise God for the beautiful and faithful families and friends of MSL members and missionaries. Pray that they continue to work and work closer with the Master. Pray for God’s protection, guidance and sustenance for them and that they will continue to flourish in all their endeavours. Pray that those needing salvation will encounter the Lord Jesus Christ.

Wed. May 29: Global Youths – Ask God to put a deep hunger and thirst of giving Jesus Christ the honour due His name in the hearts of youths of this generation. That they may continually hunger and thirst after righteousness in all their ways. Pray that in all their search, adventure and enquiries, they would find Jesus Christ. Pull down every stronghold preventing youths from worshiping and serving Christ.

Thurs. May 30: Emigration and Human Trafficking – Human race is gradually debasing due to emigration, displacement and human trafficking. Pray that this generation would realise that Christ is the ultimate and that only in Him can one find peace, joy and satisfaction (wholesomeness). Pray for global justice and righteousness that will erase the need for these risky endeavours and for African youths to encounter Jesus Christ, the Lord of peace who gives true satisfaction and fulfilment.

Fri. May 31: Nigerian Church – The role of Nigerian Church in God’s global agenda is very important, especially in defending the Christian faith and in contributing to the revitalisation of the waning Church globally. Therefore, pray against the strongholds of syncretism and idolatry in the Nigerian Church to enable her carry out these global responsibilities. In like manner, pray for yourself that you will be a faithful and courageous witness for Christ in Nigeria.

June

Sat. June 01: Nigeria – The deterioration in the nation’s economy has continued to pose serious challenges to the endeavours of missions organizations in the country. Ask God to heal the nation’s economy and cause resources for missions to abound to facilitate the spreading of the Gospel. Continue to pray that godliness and justice will prevail over every form of evil and that the activities of the enemy will not ruin the country.

Sun. June 02: The Tuaregs in North Africa – The Tuareg are passive Muslims with a complex social orientation believing strongly in charms and spirits. Ask God to raise a prayer team to soften the hearts of these His precious people so that they enjoy salvation in Christ Jesus. Pray that the power of the Holy Spirit will degrade the power of charms and demonic spirits in their lives and ask God to orchestrate special encounters with their key leaders that would lead to massive repentance among them.

Mon. June 03: Cote d'Ivoire – Ask God to unveil new strategies to the missions training institutes in the land on how best to prepare missionaries for Islamic out reaches and pray that such institutions would produce spiritually endowed Ivorian missionaries for the harvest field. Pray that the focus of Ivorian Church would be on the unreached and not on the members and ask Jesus to deliver the believers completely from traditional/cultural practices.

Tues. June 04: Benin Republic – Pray that the Gospel of Jesus Christ will take root in Benin to see every region reached and churches planted among people groups in the land. The land is fertile for Christianity; ask God to raise and equip missionaries that would combine gospel proclamation with rural development, education and health care in order to render holistic ministry to the unreached people in this country. Pray for effectual open doors for evangelism, discipleship and teachings.

Wed. June 05: Ghana – Other religions are attempting to make reach Ghanaians with their messages, pray that the aggressive out reaches will stop. Pray that the evangelicals in Ghana would wake up to the challenge and reach out to the thousands of unreached and needy peoples in the land. Ask God to shine the light of the Gospel into the hearts of the 1.7 million “Christians” without a link to any church and the millions of Christians who still place some value on traditional beliefs in Ghana.

Thurs. June 06: Niger Republic – There is considerable freedom of religion in this nation, though with a few restrictions on missions related activities. Pray and nullify every hindrance to the advancement of the Gospel of Jesus Christ. Pray that the knowledge and glory of God would cover Niger Republic as the waters cover the seas to liberate the people from physical poverty and spiritual bondage. Pray for material and human resources for holistic out reach and evangelism and ask God to encounter and stabilise the devastated youths in Niger Republic.

Fri. June 07: Chad – Earnestly pray against the spirit of nominalism, disunity and syncretism in the Chadian Church and ask God to unit the churches so that they can together harvest the numerous unreached groups in the land. Pray for proper discipleship and correct teachings of the Bible to enable believers to discern between truth and lies. Also pray for the churches to be passionate and love to pray for, give and reach out to the unreached peoples in Chad.

Sat. June 08: North Korea – Pray for the liberation of the many Christians imprisoned for their faith in North Korea. Suffering with deprivation is severe in this nation; ask Jesus to encounter the leaders just as He did to Paul and cause them to repent and believe in Him. The country prohibits distribution of Scriptures and other Christian materials, which make them very scarce and dear to believers in the land. Ask God to continue to make them available in His own way and to protect believers in this very hostile nation.

Sun. June 09: Kosovo-Europe – Christianity in this European nation is less than 10% and their economy is fragile and poor. Ask God to work in the lives of these people to diminish their dislike for Christianity. Pray that they would see the love and light of Jesus Christ as accept Him as Saviour. Pray for unity among the few believers and for spiritual and numerical growth for the Church of Christ in the land of Kosovo.

Mon. June 10: France – Pray against the growth of atheism and the widespread involvement with occult practices in France. Many have never meaningfully encountered the gospel of Jesus Christ. Ask the Lord of harvest to thrust out labourers to reach out to them. Pray that the believers will be transparent and of good conduct to influence the society and people of France with the transforming message of the Gospel.

Tues. June 11: Turkish People of Northern Cyprus – There is a dislike and prejudice towards Christianity in this Republic. Pray that the power and love in name of our Lord Jesus Christ would overcome the historic, ethnic and cultural hatred and prejudices that hinder the Gospel from penetrating the land and the lives of the people. Pray that God would burden people to pray and to reach out to this needy unreached people group.

Wed. June 12: Qatar – Pray that the opportunities in the Christian communities will promote strong unity among the churches, greater desire for witnessing and effective discipleship of the few believers in Qatar. Ask Christ to reveal Himself to Qataris both home and abroad, especially to their key leaders and family heads. Ask God to continue to equip and flourish the Media ministry to meet the spiritual need of the people.

Thurs. June 13: Iraq – Pray for a miraculous breakthrough in the land that would transform Iraq by God's love and justice. Pray for the free proclamation of the good news so that there will be healing and restoration upon the land. Pray that the expatriate believers would respond to hatred and persecution with boldness, forgiveness and love of Christ to enable them reach out to the people with the Gospel. Ask God to sustain the few indigenous believers to endure the pains and difficulties of persecution and opposition.

Fri. June 14: Yemen – Pray that the power of the Holy Spirit would miraculously overrule the legal system of this nation to enable freedom of religion. Majority of the Christians are expatriates, ask God for grace for them to remain faithful in the face of discouragement, isolation and constant threat to their stay in the country. Pray for God's wisdom, boldness and resources for them to reach out the numerous Yemenis holistically.

Sat. June 15: The Unreached People – Using Psalm 67, pray for God's grace, blessing and favour upon the unreached people of the world so that they may know God. Pray that they experience His salvation and Lordship among them that they all will praise and fear only Him. Stand against the strongholds binding these groups of people and pray that the light and love of Christ would liberate them. Pray that the glory of God would overwhelm 10/40 window.

Sun. June 16: Spiritual Leaders – Pray that spiritual leaders will not be found wanting even as they train and lead others to become like Christ and pray that they will remain committed in ministry and epitomise Christ in life and character. Ask God to reward their labour with abiding fruits and pray for God's safety, guidance, wisdom and sustenance for them as they go about fulfilling the Great Commission.

Mon. June 17: Missionaries – Pray that missionaries will maintain an intimate relationship with God, remaining in His presence always and pray that they will never become too familiar with God. Pray also that every missionary will continually be guided to work according to God's plan for their lives. Ask the Lord to bless their efforts with bountiful harvest of souls and supply all their needs according to His riches in glory.

Tues. June 18: Omega2 Project of Four Square Church, Asokoro – Ask God to continue to flourish and sustain this project that is a blessing to many missionaries. Pray that He will continue to envision the leaders towards the furtherance of the Gospel of Jesus Christ. Pray for God's safety, guidance and blessings in all their endeavours and for wisdom and grace to remain focused and dedicated unto our Lord Jesus Christ.

Wed. June 19: Shua Arabs, Borno State – Nullify in Prayers the powers and beliefs that hinder the Gospel of light among these people. Pray that the love of Christ will be made manifest among the Shua Arabs. Pray God to open their hearts to accept the truth of the Gospel of Jesus Christ and to reveal Jesus to their religious leaders. Pray for grace, perseverance and protection for those reaching out to them and ask God to raise and equip more labourers to take the good news to these His precious people.

Thurs. June 20: Rashe People, Kebbi & Niger States – Pray that these people will receive the revelation and understanding of Jesus Christ who alone can deliver them from all forms of oppression. Ask God to grant the few believers grace and boldness to witness to their people despite strong opposition and pray that those desiring to follow Jesus Christ will overcome the threats of persecution and become followers of Christ. Pray that the completion of the translation work in their language will revive their identity.

Fri. June 21: Tera People, Yobe and Bauchi States – Pray that the power of the Gospel Jesus Christ will bring salvation to the people and the land of Tera. Pray that the few Tera Christians in Bauchi State will see the need to reach their people located in different places with the gospel of peace and love. Ask God to encounter the family heads and village leaders in Tera land and bring them to repentance and to enjoy salvation in Christ.

Sat. June 22: Buduma People, Borno State – The new converts among this people are afraid of persecution and opposition from their families and communities. Ask God to set them free from the spirit of fear so that they can boldly worship Jesus Christ. Pray that the plight of the people will be a burden to the churches and believers in Buduma so as to reach out to the people with the Gospel of hope. Ask God to bless the efforts of the labourers among them with lasting fruits.

Sun. June 23: Laru People, Niger State – Ask God to raise prayer teams to soften and prepare this ‘virgin’ land for the penetration of the Gospel of light. Ask Him to equip passionate cross-cultural missionaries to reach out to the unreached people of Laru and pray that the people would become dissatisfied with the false religions in readiness for the Gospel of hope and eternal life.

Mon. June 24: Kyangawa People, Kebbi State – Pray against the strongholds of other religions on the people and ask God to grant the Kyangawas an understanding of the person of Jesus Christ. Ask God to give the missionaries working among them the strategies for effective ministry among the people. Pray for boldness for those who have received the Gospel and for grace to withstand the persecution that may follow.

Tues. June 25: MSL Kenya – Pray for safety and favour for John Bwire and Charles Mwai as they tour East Africa mobilising the Church to get involved in reaching out to the unreached people with the Gospel of love. Pray for God’s provision of the resources they need for ministry and for open doors and access to churches. Pray also that the churches in this region will realise their responsibilities and respond to the need of taking the gospel to the unreached people in their area.

Wed. June 26: MSL National/International Offices – Pray for God’s grace and fruitfulness in life and in ministry for the MSL members and missionaries. Ask God to make them servants that will influence people positively and good stewards of His time, resources and knowledge/word. Continue to pray for God’s protection, sustenance and guidance in all our endeavours and for the enablement to finish well and strong.

Thurs. June 27: MSL USA – Thank God for the efforts being made by MSL Chapter members in the USA to mobilise believers and raise support for their adopted mission field in Cote d’voire. Pray for favour and open doors in churches as they reach out in their mobilization drive.

Fri. June 28: Christian Homes – Thank God Almighty for the impact Christian homes are making in keep communities peaceful and safe globally. Pray earnestly that God will strengthen Christian homes to overcome the schemes of the devil in using dissension and divorces to weaken Christian homes and marriages. Ask God to restore homes and marriages going through challenges so that families can in one accord worship and serve Him. Pray that Christians Homes would honour Christ and esteem godly virtues and values continually.

Sat. June 29: MSL UK– MSL UK is supporting a very strategic work among migrant persons in the United Kingdom. Pray for the success of the partnership and for increase in the support being generated for the work. Ask the Lord to raise more believers in the UK that will support mission work across the globe.

Sun. June 30: Pray for Yourself – Praise God for bringing you to the end of the first half of the year and ask Him to help you realise that it is all about Christ and Him alone, without whom we can be or do nothing. Stand against whatever will hinder you from knowing and serving Christ better and pray that you will have a better relationship with Him. Pray for grace to be a better custodian of His word, fervent intercessor for world evangelisation and committed Christian reaching out to the unbelievers/unreached around you this second half of the year!
