Every MSL Chapter adopts a mission field for focus and establishes a strategic partnership with the missionaries working among a particular unreached people group in order to serve as a sending team for the purpose of making Jesus Christ known, worshipped, followed and glorified among the people group.

This partnership arrangement is implemented through the provision of financial/material support and an adequate prayer back-up for the missionaries and the work. Field visits are also undertaken by MSL Chapter members to enable them have a first hand knowledge of field ministry. Chapter members also provide care and hospitality to missionaries.

This is an opportunity to make a lasting difference by reaching the nations with the gospel of Jesus Christ through missions support. You can join the growing movement of missions supporters and play your part in world mission, through prayer, giving, encouraging and partnering with others.

Mission is not an exclusive preserve of missionaries. It is the corporate mandate of the Church. If you are not there as a frontline missionary, then getting involved in supportive ministry becomes mandatory. Identify with God's prime agenda and make your life relevant in this generation.

JULY

Wed. July 01: Thanksgiving — God is indeed worthy of praise! Let us appreciate God for His love, protection, grace and mercy during the first half of the year. Thank Him for the grace to overcome in moments of pain, trials, grieve, achievements and seeming failures and for the privilege to co-labour with Him through prayer and intercession for the unreached peoples. Ask for grace for a closer walk/work with God in obedience and faithfulness to intercede consistently for the salvation of nations.

Thurs. July 02: Nigeria — Thank God for His mercy upon Nigerians especially in view of the COVID-19 pandemic; by His mercies we are not consumed in spite of the poor infrastructure in our healthcare system. Ask the Lord to end this scourge and cause our leaders to invest efficiently towards the health sector. Pray that God will continue to preserve the lives of all the frontline workers in this fight against the pandemic.

Fri. July 03: Mauritania — Mauritania has only 0.25% of Christians with most of them as expatriates. Pray that Mauritanians in diaspora would encounter the Gospel, become followers of Jesus Christ and also find ways to reach out to their people back home. Pray that God would continue to minister to the few believers in the country and strengthen them despite the lack of fellowship. Pray also for the emergence of a viable indigenous Church in the land.



Sat. July 04: Burundi — Praise God for sustained evangelical growth as nearly all Protestant and Anglican churches have seen significant growth. However, shallow Christianity practiced within them is inadequate to change lives and overcome tensions among ethnic groups; pray against nominalism and syncretism amongst the Christians. Ask the Lord to shine His light in and through Burundian believers to distinguish themselves by holistic approach to ministry that exhibit Christ likeness. Pray that the Lord will raise passionate and faithful labourers for the harvest of souls in Burundi.

Sun. July 05: Mayotte — Response to the Gospel in Mayotte is very low; most of the Christians are non-indigenes. Pray that the Gospel would permeate the country to cause a massive repentance among the people. Ask God to thrust in more labourers and to sustain and strengthen those already working in the land. Ask the Lord to grant the labourers effective strategies for a bumper harvest of souls and for the emergence of vibrant indigenous Church in Mayotte.

Mon. July 06: Burkina Faso — Thank God for the multiplication of Evangelical churches in the country, though widespread idolatry and the infiltration of Islam in the northern part slow down the advancement of the Gospel in the country. Pray therefore, that the people will embrace the Gospel and discover the Truth and for Spirit-filled leaders to provide

effective discipleship and mentoring for the Christians/churches. Pray that the Holy Spirit will equip the churches for effective ministry among the unreached peoples.

Tues. July 07: Mali — Thank God for what He is doing in Mali despite the pressure for her to become an Islamic state. Pray for the emergence of viable indigenous churches among the Bambara, Soninke, Fulbe, Songhai, Dogon and Tamacheq people groups, who are strategic in evangelising the land. Also, pray for significant improvement in the literacy level to enhance the spread of the Gospel in Mali.

Wed. July 08: Ethiopia — Thank God for the unity among churches in Ethiopia and ask Him to sustain it. Pray that the Ethiopian Church would prioritise discipleship of the younger generation as they constitute the lager population of the country. Pray also for a fruitful work among the 4.5 million Ethiopianethnic Somalis Muslims. With Government's restrictions to religious broadcasts, pray therefore, that other effective means of evangelism and preaching of the Gospel will be revealed to the Church in the land.

Thurs. July 09: Indonesia — Thank God for the community of Christians in Minahasa-Sangir and Toraja and pray for revival of the churches among these people clusters. Ask God to enable the people to guard against the ingress of nominalism, cultism and false



religions. Pray for the light of God to shine among the less-reached peoples of Bugis, Gorontalo and Bungku-Bajau. Pray for the successful completion of the Bible translation in their various languages and for safety and sustenance for the translators.

Fri. July 10: Saudi Arabia — Pray for the revelation of Jesus Christ to as many as seek to see the light and know the truth in Saudi Arabia and for undeniable increase among indigenous believers. Pray for adequate recognition of human rights and the legalisation of Christianity for Saudis. Also, pray for wisdom, grace and provision for the believers to remain faithful and for spouses for believers of marriageable age. Pray for the enthronement of Jesus Christ over the nation.

Sat. July 11: Jilin Province, China — Most of the people in the Jilin Province practice a mix of Buddhism and Shamanism. Thank God for the relatively strong 7.6% Christians in this region. Using Jeremiah 6:16 pray that those led astray by pseudo-Christian cults would return to the ancient path. With increasing number of rural people migrating to the cities, pray for multiplication of churches over there. Pray for renewal of strength, courage and protection for the Chinese Korean Church as they strategically advance the Kingdom in the area.

Sun. July 12: Brunei — The Christian community live under difficult conditions;

evangelism is illegal yet the number of Christians grows with no new registrations for churches in view. Pray that the Church in Brunei would stand strong, bold and united amidst persecution and for the Lord to raise Spirit filled leaders who are versed in the Scriptures. Pray for wisdom, creative means and opened doors for the Christians to witness Jesus Christ to the unreached peoples in Brunei, especially to the key leaders.

Mon. July 13: Palestine — Let us continue to pray for peace between Palestine and Israel and for reconciliation between the Arab Christians and the Messianic Jews. Pray that God would protect, comfort and strengthen Palestinian Christians, enabling them to hold fast to their faith in spite of the trials and opposition they face. Pray that God will use the global Church to support and settle the issues of Palestinian Christians.

Tues. July 14: Malaysia — The Malay people are among the world's largest unreached groups. Legal and social barriers are high in the country; however, Christian witness is possible. Pull down all barriers hindering the spread of the Gospel in this land and pray for burden, wisdom and right strategies for the Church to reach out to the Malays with the Gospel. Ask God to equip individuals, Christians and organisations targeting the Malays with adequate grace, courage and resources for effective ministry.



Wed. July 15: Kazakh stan — Thank God for the growth of the Kazakh Church and for the two local Christian radio stations despite the high restrictions on Christian activities. Pray for increasing number of quality Christian programmes and pray that every effort to make the Gospel available in various forms and formats in the heart languages of the people will be successful with lasting results. Ask the Lord to correct every misconception about Christianity in the hearts of the people.

Thurs. July 16: Nigeria Evangelical Missions Association (NEMA) — Ask the Lord to use the new leadership mightily to enlarge the coast of NEMA in missions. Pray for unity of purpose and oneness for the leaders to operate maximally. Ask God to provide them with the grace, wisdom, strength and strategies suitable for their calling as a mission umbrella agency. Pray for safety and adequate provision for them and their family members.

Fri. July 17: The Bolewa, Yobe State — Ask the Lord to break the powers of false religions keeping the Bolewa people from understanding and embracing the Gospel. Pray that the few converts will persevere, holding firm to their faith in the midst of persecution, exhibit Christ-like character and have burden and boldness to preach the Gospel to their own people. Also, pray that the Lord will raise more labourers for the field and for availability of the Bible and other discipleship resources in Bolanci.

Sat. July 18: Vem go, Adam awa State — The influence of traditional practices is very strong among the people, therefore, pray that the Lord would deliver the Vemgo people from traditional religious practices and all forms of falsehood that have been hindering the spread of the Gospel among them. Pray that the churches working among the people will clearly distinguish the Gospel from their culture. Also, pray for more labourers for the people group, especially indigenes.

Sun. July 19: The Bashar (Yankam), Plateau State — The recent crisis in Plateau State has caused deep hurts and hatred in the hearts of the Bashar people towards Christians. Ask God to heal their hurts and erase the hatred and hostility for them to receive the Gospel. Also, pray that the people will become dissatisfied with their current religion and earnestly seek for the truth in Jesus Christ. Pray that Jesus will reveal Himself to their religious teachers and other influential people.

Mon. July 20: The Becheve, Cross Rivers State — Becheve people are stuck in a bizarre culture of giving young girls in marriage/slavery in exchange for goats, food items and in settlement of their parents' debts. Pull down this stronghold and ask God to deliver those still in this bondage. Pray for breakthrough for advocacy groups and missionaries labouring among the people to



help stop this practice and for healing and restoration of the victims.

Tues. July 21: The Bisa/Busa, Kebbi State

— Pray against the strongholds of false religions, resistance to the Gospel and hostility towards Christians among the Bisa people. Also pray that the people, especially their leaders will have supernatural encounters that will lead to their salvation. Ask that the Lord would also raise prayer/missionary teams that would faithfully intercede for the land, bear the torch of the Gospel and work in various strategic ways for the evangelization of the Bisa people.

Wed. July 22: The Gurmana, Niger State —

Ask the Lord to send more labourers into this harvest field and open the eyes of the people to recognize the truth and joyfully embrace the Gospel message. Also, pray for the revelation of Jesus Christ to the religious and family heads who wield much influence in the lives of the people. Pray against the fear of persecution that hinders the people from accepting Jesus Christ as Savoiur and Lord.

Thurs. July 23:10/40 Window — Thank God for the supernatural encounters of Christ appearing to individuals that is resulting to rapid growth of the Church in this region. Ask God to work through the 10/40 Window (Gen 1:3) and replace every stony heart with a heart of flesh so that the people here will readily accept the good news. Pray for grace, safety

and sustenance for the missionaries serving in this region and for more faithful, sacrificial and resilient Christian workers to join them.

Fri. July 24: Missionaries/Ministers' Children — Ministers' children are often the enemy's target. Pray that these children will grow in grace, wisdom, purity and the fear of the Lord. Ask God to grant them grace to overcome sinful desires and every form of temptation on their way. Pray also that they will be able to discern God's will for their lives, excel in their endeavours and be faithful witnesses for Jesus Christ in every sphere of life. Pray for the restoration of some who have gone astray.

Sat. July 25: Missions Supporters League (MSL) International Office — Pray that the Lord will raise workers for the MSL International Office from across the different continents. Also, pray that the different Boards and Councils of all the National Movements will function effectively in their oversight roles.

Sun. July 26: MSL Kenya — Ask the Lord to raise new ministry partners for all the staff in the MSL Kenya office. Pray that they find favour as they talk to believers in different spheres of life to support them. Ask the Lord to prosper the work of all their partners and to also protect them and their families.

Mon. July 27: MSL Nigeria Board and Council Members — Thank God for the



effort of MSL Board and Council members in accomplishing the mobilization mandate of the Ministry. Pray for greater grace and wisdom for them to develop fresh ideas and strategies to engage the Ministry's stakeholders effectively and for divine vigour and zeal to intensify their efforts. Pray for closer walk with God and for safety, good health and God's favour upon them and their families.

Tues. July 28: MSL Chapters and Partners

— Thank God for the lives and activities of MSL Chapter members and partners and ask Him to renew their passion for a closer walk with Him. Pray for the spiritual growth of our Chapter members and partners that will lead to more effective service unto the Lord. Pray for the improvement and enhancement of their resources for greater impact on their adopted mission fields and adequate support of missionaries to foster the accomplishment of the Great Commission. Pray for safety for the protection of all of MSL Chapter members/partners and their families.

Wed. July 29: Mission Agencies — Thank God for the unity that exists among the mission agencies in Nigeria and beyond. Ask the Lord to help them remain faithful, focused and committed to their respective calling amidst challenging situations and times. Pray for renewal of zeal, courage and strategy for grater exploits among the Unreached People Groups

(UPGs). Pray also for safety and provision of adequate resources for them to carry out the Lord's mandate effectively.

Thurs. July 30: Muslim Background Believers (MBBs) — Praise God that MBBs are among the most vibrant Christians in the world. They spend the majority of their lives in danger/isolation, hated by their countries, ostracized, beaten and in some cases murdered by their families and neighbours. Pray for grace for them to persevere in evangelizing, preaching the Gospel and serving the Lord. Pray that their love and commitment to Jesus Christ would lighten the darkest corners and parts of the Arab world.

Fri. July 31: The Universal Church — Thank God for upholding the Church globally by His mercies knowing that the gates of hell will never prevail against Her. The Church is the pillar and ground of the truth (1Tim. 3:15); pray that the Church will arise to permeate and uphold the light of the Gospel in the dark places of the earth. Pray for the unity of the Universal Church in spirit, truth and purpose to walk and work circumspectly, redeeming the time by prioritizing the Great Commission.

AUGUST

Sat. Aug. 01: Nigeria — Thank and praise God for His mighty hand upon Nigeria that is keeping the nation as an entity despite all odds. Pray that the Lordship of Jesus Christ will continue to find expression over the affairs of this nation despite the plans of the devil and his

cohorts. Pray that the power of the Holy Spirit will permeate every sector of our national life and the current Government. Pray that Nigeria's leadership will govern in righteousness and justice so that Nigeria will experience all round growth and development.

Sun. Aug. 02: Chad — Thank God for the government of Chad being truly secular in operations and for the freedom of religion. Pray that the Chadian Church would minister the Gospel to their animist and Muslim neighbours effectively. Destroy the stronghold of tribalism and nominalism and pray for the unity of the Church and for sound biblical teachings to enable Christians discern the truth. Pray for a just and committed government and for the betterment of the citizens.

Mon. Aug. 03: Senegal — The rate of Church growth is very slow with only 6.42% of the population as Christians. Therefore, pull down every stronghold keeping the people in darkness and ask the Holy Spirit to move for a massive conversion of the people. Pray for breakthrough among the strategic peoples of Wolof, Fulbe and Mande extraction. Pray for adequate supply and sustained fruitfulness for those reaching out to youths and street children.

Tues. Aug. 04: Cameroon — Stunted spiritual growth of the churches is one of the major concerns in the land, pray therefore, against

syncretism and nominalism in the churches. Pray for revival and restoration and increase in Bible reading, teaching, preaching and holiness among Christians. Pray for godly leaders and spiritual revolution in the Church that would cause progressive mission involvement of the churches. Pray for peace and mutual coexistence in this nation.

Wed. Aug. 05: Eritrea — Thank God for the stability of the Church in Eritrea that is under intense persecution and government oppression. Pray for the restoration of basic human rights and religious freedom for every citizen. Also, pray that Christians would remain faithful to Jesus Christ amidst hardship and make significant impact on their nation. The churches are moving forward under new leadership of young men or new converts; pray for divine grace and wisdom for them as they learn to lead and function effectively to God's glory.

Thurs. Aug. 06: Sierra Leone — Appreciate God for various Christian organizations involved in building the country through holistic ministries to meet the spiritual, physical, and psychological/emotional needs of the people. Pray that the labours of these Christian organizations would expand God's kingdom. Pray against the activities and influence of secret societies and occult in the land. Pray that the Church would walk in faith, purity and be a shining light in the society and among the non-Christian majority.



Fri. Aug. 07: Tunisia — Islam is the State religion with only 0.22% as Christians. The government prohibits indigenous churches from owning properties and having bank accounts and the Christian population is predominantly nominal. Ask God to reverse the situations and break all barriers to the spread of the Gospel in the land. Pray for a revival that would cause unprecedented harvest of souls into God's kingdom in Tunisia with the return of buildings and land the State confiscated previously.

Sat. Aug. 08: Somalia — Thank God for the emergence of Somali Church amid tribulation. Somali Christians are despised, persecuted and even martyred, yet they keep growing in faith and vision. Pray for their protection, increased discipleship and fellowship opportunities for the believers. Pray for sustenance and perseverance of Christians in this difficult situation and for vibrant Christian homes that would serve as discipleship and fellowship centres. Ask God to erase every false notion about Christianity in the land.

Sun. Aug. 09: Europe — Thank God for the positive impact of immigrant believers and the objective media houses in spreading the Gospel in Europe. Pray that every effort to liberate the Church in Europe from the clutches of Satan will be fruitful. Pray also for faithful and biblically sound leaders to pastor, teach, evangelize and plant churches in places where none exists. Using Isaiah 54:13,

earnestly pray for the younger generation growing up in a context that is almost devoid of Christian values and witness.

Mon. Aug. 10: Pacific Region — The influx of false religious ideologies is a threat to the Gospel in this region; thereby contributing to the decline in spiritual growth of traditional denominations. Pray against the spirits behind the false religions and ask the Lord to revive the churches. Pray that the younger generation would hunger and thirst after God and become faithful followers of Jesus Christ. Pray that the Church in the Pacific would prioritise discipleship and moral values.

Tues. Aug. 11: The Arabs — The Arab world consists of 22 countries with a total population of about 423 million people most of whom are unreached. Pray that they will have meaningful contact with the Gospel and turn to Jesus Christ for their salvation. Also, pray for the indigenous Christians to become courageous, shining lights and faithful witnesses of Jesus Christ among their own people. Pray for safety and adequate provision for Christian workers among the Arabs.

Wed. Aug. 12: Asia — Thank God for the massive number of unreached peoples turning to Jesus Christ in the region and pray for more labourers and fruitful work among them. Pray for more revelations of Christ among the various people blocks. Ask for God's grace and courage for many Christians under persecution



and pressure not to succumb to societal norms. Pray for grace, safety and adequate resources for missionaries labouring in the Asia region.

Thurs. Aug. 13: United States of America (USA) — With less than three months to the general election, the stakes are high as the future of America hangs on only what God can do. Therefore, ask God to overrule every satanic agenda and anything opposed to His will. Pray that the American people would team up with God by electing the right candidates to uphold His honour and counsel in the land. Pray for mercy over other things that might want to threaten the wellbeing of Americans.

Fri. Aug. 14: China — Thank God for the survival and growth of the Church in China. Continue to pray that Christians might walk and serve faultlessly to be redemptive instruments within government and society at large. Ask God to override the atheistic views propagated in the educational system and to raise more godly leaders to provide sound biblical counsel in issues relating to the family, ethics, society and faith life. One of such negative trends is the increasing acceptance of extra-marital affairs as a cultural norm.

Sat. Aug. 15: India — Pray for the sustenance of the constitutional religious freedom in India and that Christians will utilise this positive development wisely. Pray that the political and

religious leaders of India will encounter Jesus in amanner that would cause them to surrender to IIIs Lordship. Pray also for the mass conversion of the youths and people from the high caste that constitutes very strategic gateway groups in the nation.

Sun. Aug. 16: Northern Nigeria — Thank God for sustaining His children resident in this part of the country despite all odds. Pray for His continuous sustenance upon their lives in difficult situations raging from terrorism to other forms of security challenges. Pray that Christians will not be weary in praying for the North until Christ is enthroned as the Saviour and Lord over the area. Ask God to remove the deceitful veil preventing the non-Christians from accepting the true love of Jesus Christ.

Mon. Aug. 17: Omega2 Project of Four Square Church, Asokoro — Pray for continuous favour from God upon this strategic mission project and pray against whatever will attempt to hinder its effectiveness in carrying out the Great Commission. Pray for God's goodness and mercy upon the lives of the vision bearers and pray that they will not lose focus in godliness and ministry. Ask the Lord to grant members of the congregation the grace, courage and wisdom to carry on with their various responsibilities.

Tues. Aug. 18: Nigeria Fellowship of Evangelical Students (NIFES) — Thank God for the good works He is using NIFES to

accomplish in the areas of youth evangelisation and discipleship among students on campuses. Pray for the resources (human and financial) needed for the effective running of NIFES operations across the country and beyond. Ask God to provide the staff members with grace, safety, wisdom and strength commensurate to their tasks.

Wed. Aug. 19: Go International — Thank God for the tremendous work Go International is doing among the unreached nations. Pray for God's safety and sustenance upon the lives of the workers as they carry out their duties in different fields and offices. Pray for the provision of the necessary resources for the smooth and effective running of the Ministry. Ask the Lord to grant their leaders the insight, wisdom and direction for effective leadership.

Thurs. Aug. 20: Cave Missions — Pray for grace, wisdom and fresh outpouring of the Holy Spirit upon the staff and leaders of Cave Missions. Pray for effectiveness in all discipleship and church planting efforts and for workers that will work for the expansion of God's kingdom. Ask God to bless the Ministry with faithful and purposeful partners. Pray for good health and abundant supplies for the missionaries and for their family members.

Fri. Aug. 21: El-Rehoboth (M2414) — Bless the Lord for the positive impact of El-Rehoboth in the fulfilment of the Great Commission. Pray that God will continue to

reveal His mind and plans to the leadership of the Ministry and that they will follow His leading in all their planning and operations. Pray for provision of all they need to remain faithful and effective in their area of calling.

Sat. Aug. 22: Christian Missionary Foundation (CMF) — Pray for a fresh touch and inspiration of the Holy Spirit upon the life of every leader and staff of CMF. Ask God to grant them breakthrough with massive conversions on the fields they are working on and pray that viable churches will emerge on those fields. Pray for young and vibrant missionaries and partners for the Ministry. Pray for safety, enablement and provision for the running of the Ministry generally.

Sun. Aug. 23: Calvary International Africa

— Pray that the vision of Calvary International and God's mandate will come to fulfilment through the work of the Ministry. Ask the Lord to open greater and wider doors of ministry and partnership among the people groups they are working. Pray that the staff members will work and walk closely with God in total obedience and for greater grace and wisdom for their leadership team. Pray for grace, safety, resources and fruitfulness for all of them.

Mon. Aug. 24: MSL National Office — Thank God for His faithfulness to all MSL missionaries and for the fruitfulness in their services. Pray for grace, boldness and

protection as they carry out their daily assignments. Ask the Lord to adequately equip and empower the missionaries for greater Kingdom exploit. Pray also for focus and dedication for the staff and for more effective and passionate partners for the work.

Tues. Aug. 25: MSL Projects and Programmes — MSL has projects and programmes for the year, even though slowed down by the COVID 19 challenge; pray for wisdom on how to run the programmes and successfully execute them. Pray for adequate funds for the MSL Centre project, production of mobilization materials, State Summits, Staff Welfare Intervention Fund and others. Pray that more Christians will be meaningfully involved in missions through these strategic programmes.

Wed. Aug. 26: MSL Family and Friends —

These are very important part of the Ministry, playing key roles in advancing the Kingdom through MSL platform. Praise God for His grace, protection and provision for them and ask Him to continually keep them in good health and bless the works of their hands. Ask God to rekindle their love for Him and for the Great Commission and to help them uphold and live Christ-centred lifestyles.

Thurs. Aug. 27: MSL Staff and Missionaries

— Thank God for His grace, strength and good health upon the lives of MSL workers in their

course of service; indeed, God has been faithful in sustaining them. Pray for a more intimate relationship with Christ for them and that their lives will exhibit the nature and love of God to people around them. Ask the Lord to sharpen their vision and grant them joy, peace, focus and fulfilment as they serve Him.

Fri. Aug. 28: MSL East Africa — Thank God for open doors to start National Movements in the East African region; ask the Lord to raise and sustain volunteers and partners from various churches that will work with the Regional Director to advance the work in the Region. Pray for provision for the Regional Director and for safety in his travels.

Sat. Aug. 29: Church Leaders in Nigeria — Praise God for the Spiritual Leaders of Nigeria and ask for divine protection and mercy on their behalf. Ask God to clean and purge them from every form of evil association and equip them afresh for proper leadership of His people in this country. Frustrate all ungodly decrees and anti-Christ agenda that might be challenging to them and pray that they will never at any time compromise their faith. Pray that God's wisdom, discernment and knowledge will always flood their hearts.

Sun. Aug. 30: Bible Translators — Thank God for the efforts of the translators in making the Bible and other Christian materials available in various languages of the peoples

of the earth. Pray for divine sustenance, safety and for good health for them and their family members. Pray against every barrier and the onslaught of the enemy towards the Ministry and the workers. Pray for grace, boldness, inspiration and wisdom for them to remain faithful at their duty posts.

Mon. Aug. 31: Nigerian Church — Using Acts 2: 42, pray for strong desire for the Church of Christ in Nigeria to be devoted to sound teaching like the disciples of old. Pray that the minds of Christians be focussed on evangelism and discipleship of converts. Pray for divine wisdom, knowledge and grace for the leaders in guiding, mentoring and caring for members. Pray that the Church will pay attention to the Great Commission.

SEPTEMBER

Tues. Sept. 01: Nigeria — Continue to pray for wisdom for our leaders to harness and manage our God given resources effectively for the good of the citizens. Ask God to deliver Nigeria from decay and instability in all ramifications, ranging from electricity supply, roads, portable water, hunger with disharmony in almost every sector. Pray that Nigerians will develop more positive attitude to national development as well as to learn to be accountable.

Wed. Sept. 02: Madagascar — Thank God for the multiplication of small congregations and

house fellowship groups; Pray that these groups will continue to grow in Scriptures and spiritual understanding. Pray for a revival that will cause greater unity among leaders and churches and pray that pride and jealousy will give way to humility and kingdom consciousness. Children and youths are vital to the future of the Church, ask God to bless the efforts of the Ministries working among them with abiding fruits.

Thurs. Sept. 03: The Gambia — Pray that the Gambian Church would maximize the religious freedom to reach out to the numerous Muslims deliberately. Pray for divine wisdom, protection, provision and fruitfulness for those engaged in various aspects of ministry to the unreached peoples and Muslim Background Believers (MBBs). Pull down the power of false religions to enable more of the people to come to freedom in Christ. Pray for the availability of complete Bible in the indigenous languages.

Fri. Sept. 04: Zimbabwe — Thank God for the growth of the Church amidst opposition and pray for the rule of law and justice to prevail in Zimbabwe. The Church needs resources for leadership development, community development, mission research, mobilization and sustainable church planting. Pray for resources commensurate to the accomplishment of these noble projects and pray that there will be true expressions of



biblical faith rooted in God's Word among the churches.

Sat. Sept. 05: Egypt — Persecution against Christians is prevalent in Egypt; pray that Christians will remain faithful in spite of the persecution. Pray for those coerced or enticed to other religions to retrace their steps back to God. Pray also that Egyptian Christians would be strong witnesses for Christ in word and in deed to the entire Arab world. Many Evangelical churches have no trained pastors; pray for opportunities and resources for pastoral and missionary trainings. Pray for fruitfulness in the activities of the Gospel Christian media.

Sun. Sept. 06: Western Sahara — This desert region with huge phosphate deposits and a rich sea-fishing area is prone to crisis due to its divergent political and economic interests. Majority of the people are Muslims; pray for miraculous saturation of the area with the glory of God. Pray for revival for the Church to renew the love and zeal of the Christians for Christ and for lasting fruit for those labouring among the least reached peoples.

Mon. Sept. 07: Kenya — Pray that all traces of nominalism and tribalism in Kenyan Church be removed by the working of the Holy Spirit as the Lord helps believers in the country to work together in targeting the Unreached People Groups (UPGs). Pray that the Church in

the land will unite in opposing whatever is wrong and in upholding policies that honour God. Ask the Lord to raise and appoint faithful and dedicated believers into positions of influence.

Tues. Sept. 08: Tanzania — Ask the Lord to send out more workers to reach the unreached groups in the land and for the production and use of effective Christian materials in the heart languages of the people. Pray for sustained maturity and unity among the churches for them to reach out to the Muslims and animists successfully. Ask God to raise trained and mature leaders for effective discipleship in the churches and to reveal Jesus Christ to the key leaders of the unreached peoples of Tanzania.

Wed. Sept. 09: Hong Kong — Appreciate God for the unity among the churches in Hong kong and pray for revival to engulf the churches. Pray for astute individuals and ministries to help shape a biblical worldview for the people as a whole. Pray for more godly leaders and for provision of structures for worship and other ministry purposes. The people have variety of religions; pray that they receive the light of Jesus Christ and embrace Him as their Saviour and Lord.

Thurs. Sept. 10: Bangladesh — Pray that the religious freedom enjoyed in the land will be maintained. Pray for unity and revival of the Church in Bangladesh to liberate her from



frivolities and nominalism and to empower her for cooperative evangelism and discipleship. Pray that Lord will raise more full-time pastors and spiritually mature lay leaders for the churches. Pray that the unreached would perceive and accept the Truth of the Gospel.

Fri. Sept. 11: Kerala State of India — Kerala has the largest number of Christians in India and there is tension among the various church groups currently. Pray for the unity of the churches and for them to place God's Kingdom above their own interests. Social barriers are very high in the State, pray for the liberation of believers from the spirit of the caste system so that they can freely evangelise across caste and social groups and to welcome converts as brethren. Pray for divine grace, safety and sustenance for the Gospel ministers in India.

Sat. Sept. 12: Finland — The Church in Finland is faced with many rootless and disillusioned members moving from one church to another and lack commitment to one fellowship. Pray for revival for the Church in the country to enable members stand firm and integrate fully. Pray for open doors for the younger leaders to have a positive influence on the national Church. Ask God to bless the efforts of the ministries targeting the youths.

Sun. Sept. 13: Iraq — Thank God for the growth of Evangelicals in Iraq and pray for sustained unity among believers. Pray that believers develop a Christ-like lifestyle that responds to hatred and persecution with

courage, forgiveness and love. Pray for comfort, boldness and wisdom for the women responsible for pastoral and discipleship programmes. Pray that Iraqis would have meaningful access to the Gospel and for the protection of Christians in Iraq.

Mon. Sept. 14: Jilin Province, Northeast China — The recent rise of pseudo-Christian cults in Jilin is a threat to the Church, even some pastors and church leaders have been led astray. Pray against the activities of these cults and pray for the restoration of those who have strayed as a result of the wrong teachings. Pray also for greater grace, wisdom, safety and fruitfulness for the South Korean believers as they reach out to the unreached groups in the province and beyond.

Tues. Sept. 15: Guadeloupe, France — Guadeloupe is a France overseas region in the Southern Caribbean Sea. Pray for wisdom and resources for France and Guadeloupe's leaders to render peaceful and good standard of living for long-term benefit to the people. Pray that the Gospel would penetrate, transform and uplift the entire land to end the racial tension and class envy. Christianity (Catholicism) is a social veneer for many, pray for revival for the Church that would lead many to true repentance in this Island.

Wed. Sept. 16: Southern Nigeria — Pray fervently for revival among the churches in the South of Nigeria that would awaken all



Christians to serve the Lord more fervently. Pray that the Christian leaders will have an irresistible encounter with Jesus Christ to become Christ-like leaders. Pray also for just and effective governance among the three tiers of Government in the Zone. Pray against whatever would destabilise or discourage the Southerners from being godly, joyful and fulfilled.

Thurs. Sept. 17: The Eloyi, Benue and Plateau States — Pray that people of Eloyi will experience the peace of the Lord to enable them cohabit with others peacefully. Ask God to cause an irresistible yearning for Christ in the hearts of the people and to send out faithful labourers to serve among them. Pray that the few Eloyi believers will remain firm, faithful and courageous to witness Christ to their people.

Fri. Sept. 18: The Gerawa, Bauchi State —

Pray against every hindrance to the spread of the Gospel among the Gerawa people and that God would grant them broken and contrite hearts towards accepting the Gospel. Pray for liberation of the people from the spirit of fear to boldness in Christ Jesus. Ask God to grant those serving in the land breakthrough especially among the key leaders of the community. Pray for the emergence of a viable indigenous Church.

Sat. Sept. 19: The Fulani — Pray for a remarkable encounter with numerous unreached Fulani groups that would cause them to accept Jesus Christ as Saviour, especially among their leaders. Pray that their story of perpetuating evil will become testimonies of massive revival of the Fulani people. Ask God to continue to uphold the few believers among them, granting them the grace they need to remain faithful and the courage to reach out to their people. Pray for grace, boldness and safety for those working among them.

Sun. Sept. 20: The Dong, Taraba and Adamawa States — Dong people are mostly animists and this makes them fertile ground for the Lord's harvest; pray that the Gospel will flourish in their midst. Ask Jesus Christ to reveal Himself to the people, especially to their leaders in a way that they cannot resist Him. Pray for equipped missionaries to serve among the people and for the availability of Jesus Film and other necessary Christian materials in the people's heart language and for an indigenous Church to emerge.

Mon. Sept. 21: The Duwai/Ngizim, Yobe and Kano States — This group of people are purely Muslims and not hostile to non-indigenes, which makes them accessible. Pray for intercessors to till the land for the penetration of the Gospel. Pray for grace, sustenance and faithfulness for the few



indigenous believers and for courage for them to collaborate with the resident Christians to spread the Gospel in the land. Pray for emergence of missionaries with specific vision for the people and for adequate resources for work.

Tues. Sept. 22: The Iku, Kaduna State — Thank God for the few indigenous believers amongst many Muslims and pray that they remain faithful to the end. Pray for grace for the Christians in the land to develop burden and courage to reach out to the dominant unbelievers. Pray also, that agencies and individuals will indicate interest in reaching out to the people and for availability of Christian materials in their heart language.

Wed. Sept. 23: MSL USA — Thank God for the strategic work MSL USA is doing to support Unreached People Groups (UPGs) in two African countries. Ask the Lord to help MSL USA raise more resources for their adopted mission field and global missions. Ask God to keep them safe and sustain the leaders and members of their families.

Thurs. Sept. 24: MSL New Frontiers — The New Frontiers focuses on mobilizing youths for sustainable mission work. Thank God for the efforts of New Frontiers in reaching out to the youths and for fruitful ministry. Pray for greater grace, wisdom and favour for the Youth Mobilization Officer (YMO) as he does his duty. Ask God to rekindle the fire and passion

for missions in the hearts of the few volunteers working with the YMO and to grant them fulfilment as they serve on this platform.

Fri. Sept. 25: MSL Leadership — The times are getting tougher for missions support and this is posing a serious concern for the leadership. Pray that God will release upon the leadership wisdom, discernment, knowledge and understanding for ideas, strategies and policies that will thrive above the current economic situation to increase missions support. Ask God to influence every decision of the leadership to fulfil His purpose and release grace for total obedience to His will.

Sat. Sept. 26: MSL UK — Pray that the Lord will rekindle the fire of mission support among the MSL UK members. Ask God to raise more committed members that will join the small group to build a more formidable team of supporters. Pray for open doors in churches and fellowships for mobilization efforts.

Sun. Sept. 27: Christian Workers — It is becoming more difficult to be a Christian these days due to multiplied wickedness and evil (Matt 24:12). Pray that Christian workers remain steadfast and faithful in their walk and work with God and not to allow His grace upon them be in vain. Pray for fresh anointing and power of the Holy Spirit on all workers to experience joy, peace, fulfilment and abundant fruit in ministry. Pray also for good health and resources for their service and livelihood.



Mon. Sept. 28: Youths Glob ally — The devil is out with his arsenals to occupy and deceive the youths from seeking and following their Creator. Pray that youths globally would seek the Lord, making His word (Bible) their companion and obeying His commands. Pray for the increase of dedicated and faithful mentors to reach out and disciple them. Pray that youths will avoid lustful passions and deceitful desires to strive for peace, agape love, righteousness and holiness.

Tues. Sept. 29: Christian Homes — Thank God for His love and kindness towards Christian Homes and pray that they will indeed epitomise godly homes. Pray for peace in homes where Jesus Christ is truly the foundation and reason for existence. Ask God to help parents to be godly thereby influencing their children with godly values and character in these evil days. Pray that Christian Homes will become places where Christ is at the centre of their lives.

Wed. Sept. 30: Body of Christ in Africa —

The Lord has placed a serious responsibility with much expectation on the body of Christ in Africa. Pray that she will not disappoint God but stand strong to the fulfilment of His will and purpose. Pray that African Church will indeed fulfil the hope of world Christian revival and evangelisation. Pray against the spirit of nominalism, syncretism and materialism. Pray for the unity of faith and purpose and for grace for the Church.

OCTOBER

Thurs. Oct. 01: Nigeria — Praise God, Nigeria is 60 today! Thank God for holding firm the pillars of this great nation in spite of the many threats to her corporate existence. Pray for the peace of Nigeria and that justice and righteousness be entrenched in every segment of the society and for the restoration of the spirit of unity that was evident in the past. Ask God to erase everything hampering the meaningful development of Nigeria in all areas.

Fri. Oct. 02: Political Leadership — Pray that God will bless Nigeria with visionary and godly leaders that would uphold justice and righteousness. Pray for grace, safety and wisdom for the political leaders and that they would serve the nation with accountability, humility and transparency. Ask God to honour those working for the good of the nation and for a change of heart for those with sinister motives to steer Nigeria in the right direction especially now.

Sat. Oct. 03: Malawi — Pray that the Malawian Church be equipped and empowered for persistent and loving witnessing to Muslims in the land. Pray for unity and revival among the churches; pray against nominalism and growing influence of false religions. Ask the Lord to stir the hearts of more people to pastoral calling and for funds



for their training. Pray for the salvation of Yawo people and for the emergence of a thriving Church among them.

Sun. Oct. 04: Senegal — Some form of ungodly spiritual heaviness covers the land and allegiance to religious leaders prevents significant people movement to Christ. Using Isaiah 45:2 and Psalm 107:16 ask God to break every barrier and cause the Gospel work to prosper in the land. Pray that the Evangelical churches among the Bassari, Balanta and Jola would continue to grow and demonstrate strong Christian identity in Senegal. Pray that the ongoing mission activities in Dakar be fruitful.

Mon. Oct. 05: Congo — Pray for fresh move of the Holy Spirit in the churches for revival and restoration to do away with flawed ungodly world views and beliefs. Ask God to erase the Marxist indoctrinations of youths for them to embrace the truth as revealed in the Scriptures. Pray for fruitful outreaches to the unreached groups, especially the urban Muslims and for successful completion of the Bible translation in the people's mother tongue.

Tues. Oct. 06: Cape Verde — Pray for the emergence of government leaders that will strategically develop the economy for the benefit of the whole nation. Most of the people practice Catholicism, but mostly influenced by

superstitions and African fetishism. Pray for the people to have correct understanding of the Gospel and to exercise genuine faith in Jesus Christ. Also, pray for the availability of Scriptures in the people's heart languages and for more trained pastors and leaders.

Wed. Oct. 07: The Sahel Region — Pray that the light of the Gospel will shine into the hearts of the approximately 354 Muslim Unreached People Groups (UPGs) in this region to cause a bountiful harvest among them. Pray for availability of the Bible in various languages of the anumerous unreached groups in the region. Ask the Lord to bring to an end the injustice and terrorist activities for peace to reign in the Sahel region.

Thurs. Oct. 08: The Tuaregs — The Tuaregs are Berber nomads inhabiting some African countries and majority of them practice Islam while few are traditionalists. Ask the Lord to break all barriers trying to hinder them from salvation in Christ and to also soften their hearts to receive the Gospel. Pray for the sustenance of the few indigenous Christians; for wisdom, fruitfulness and safety for the labourers and for the emergence of indigenous churches among the people.

Fri. Oct. 09: Botswana — Continue to pray for a reversal of the moral decline and for revival to promote godliness among the Twana people in Botswana. Pray for the steady growth



of the churches and for Christians to be able to express their faith in biblical ways and within acceptable cultural parameters without compromise. Pray that the unity among the churches be sustained for greater penetration and influence among the unreached groups and on the nation generally.

Sat. Oct. 10: Gansu Province, China — This is one of China's poorest and least-developed provinces. The Christian population is steadily growing especially due to compassionate ministry by Christians to the sick and needy and the faithful witness by lay preachers. Ask the Lord to empower His Church spiritually and economically for greater impact and for more trained church leaders. Pray for spiritually vibrant churches among the least reached groups.

Sun. Oct. 11: Haiti — Thank God for the growth in the number of Evangelical Christians in the land and the increase in concerted prayers with the clear demonstration of the power of God. Pray that the peoples of Haiti, especially the Christians would experience transformation and a personal relationship with Christ. Pray for total liberation of the people from the spirit of voodoo and for the success of Christian radio broadcasts. Pray also for the availability of Bibles and other discipleship materials.

Mon. Oct. 12: Laos — Appreciate God for the rapid growth of the Church in this Buddhist

nation amid trials and opposition. Pray for continued boldness and grace for Laotians to share the Gospel and for grace and perseverance for those singled out for persecution, especially pastors and church leaders. Pray that believers will grow strong in faith and not fall away, be united and remain light and salt in their societies. Pray for the massive conversion of the people to faith in Christ.

Tues. Oct. 13: Azerbaijan — The Church is growing amidst trials and harsh legal restrictions against religious groups. Congregations can only function at their locations of registration with a very stringent registration process. Pray for the reverse of these restrictions and for revival among Orthodox churches for effective and increased Kingdom service and fruitfulness. Pray for the salvation of the large number of the unreached people in the land.

Wed. Oct. 14: Tajikistan — The Tajik Church is growing; pray for sustained unity, spiritual growth and increase in numerical strength. Ask God to envision and empower the believers to share the Gospel with the indigenes with meaningful results. Pray for effective contextual outreach efforts and church structures for rural church planting and for revelations and opportunities for the Muslims to discover Christ as the Way, the Truth and the Life. Pray for increased grace for Gospel ministers in Tajikistan.



Thurs. Oct. 15: Solom on Islands — Pray for continuous blessing upon the efforts of the Church towards reconciliation and true forgiveness to enable the nation and the Gospel to progress meaningfully. Ask the Lord to expel the forces of nominalism, stagnation, ethnic diversity and fragmentation from the Church. Pray for oneness, unity of purpose and effective discipleship programmes for the churches on the Islands. Ask God to bless the holistic ministries and the ministers with material resources and more committed workers.

Fri. Oct. 16: Macedonia — Ask God to revive the Orthodox Church and increase the love, unity and synergy among the various church denominations to attract many to Christ. Pray for fruitful mission outreaches to the least reached groups such as the Albanians, Romanians and Turkish peoples; ask the Lord to grant the various mission bodies divine strategies for productive ministry among them. Pray for a reformed and good governance of the nation for national development.

Sat. Oct. 17: Calvary Ministries (CAPRO)

— Thank God for His sustenance over CAPRO staff in crisis prone areas and for their dogged commitment to spread the Gospel in such areas. Pray for greater grace, courage and wisdom for the labourers in those areas to forge ahead in their divine mandate. Ask the

Lord to reward their efforts with the conversion of radical Muslims and fundamentalists and cause the Islamic leaders and teachers to encounter Jesus Christ in an irresistible manner.

Sun. Oct. 18: Grace Foundation Inland Missions(GFIM) — Appreciate God for all the missionaries, their family members and ministry partners and pray for grace, courage and wisdom for mutual relationship and commitment for effective ministry. Pray that God will continue to grant them the passion and right strategies for their work and ask Him to bless them with abiding fruit and vibrant churches in their fields. Pray for more open doors of partnership and ministry.

Mon. Oct. 19: Great Commission Movement of Nigeria (GCM) — Thank God for the positive influence of GCM across the nation and beyond; pray that the staff members will never lose focus or valour. Pray for continuous Christ-like leadership for the leaders and for greater grace, wisdom and courage for staff members as they labour. Also, pray for adequate resources for effective ministry and livelihood and for journey mercy in all their trips.

Tues. Oct. 20: All Christian Fellowship Missions Inc. — Thank God for the mission involvement of this Ministry in Abuja (FCT) and environs. Pray that the leadership at all



levels and every member of staff will have a clear vision of what the Lord is doing concerning missions in their area of coverage and consistently work to bring glory to Him. Pray for the emergence of godly leaders among them to direct and disciple the Church effectively. Pray for long-term workers, especially from nearby countries with seemingly same culture and traditions that will reach out to the people with the Gospel.

Nov. 04: Namibia — Pray for stability and national transformation for Namibia and that through the love of Christ victims of injustice and various kinds of abuses would find healing, forgiveness and peace. Pray that the nation's leadership will address the issues of poverty and land ownership with determination, wisdom and justice. Also, pray for spiritual rebirth leading to the restoration of biblical faith in the churches, for unity and cooperation among the Christian groups spreading the Gospel in the land.

Thurs. Nov. 05: Southern Africa — Thank God for the effort of the Church in South Africa towards mission advancement. Pray that believers will continue to epitomise Jesus Christ in word and action to attract nonbelievers to Him. Ask God to bless the labours of Christian ministries, especially those working among the youths and children. Pray for reconciliation among all races to rid the land of inequality and injustice and also pray against the spirit of violence and immorality.

Fri. Nov. 06: Comoros — The country is Islamic with severe restrictions on Christianity; evangelism is illegal and converts face opposition, even from their own families. Pray for grace, courage and wisdom for the few indigenous believers to remain firm, focused and faithful. Pray also that the expatriate Christians will be firm and faithful with the burden to reach unbelievers around



them in the hostile atmosphere. Pray for successful Christian medical outreaches in the land.

Sat. Nov. 07: Sudan — Pray for more passionate and sacrificial workers to meet the demands of the numerous unreached groups in Northern Sudan effectively. Pray for fresh grace, courage, strategies and inspiration for Christian workers to enable fruitful Gospel ministration in Sudan. Pray for wisdom and unity for the Church in Sudan to meet up with her expectation. Pray for peace to reign in South Sudan and for fair power sharing and equitable distribution of resources.

Sun. Nov. 08: Mauritius — The complexity of the society in Mauritius makes evangelism difficult; pray for divine wisdom, discernment and strategies for meaningful ministry engagements in the area. Pray for biblically sound leaders to teach, disciple and model godliness among the people. Pray that the spiritual vitality (Bible reading and teaching) currently on in the Catholic Church be sustained and spread to others for the formation of a true and balanced biblical worldview in the denomination.

Mon. Nov. 09: Jordan — Pray for the peace of the kingdom and for the king and government to work for the good of the people. Thank God for the effort of the Evangelicals in Church growth despite the pressures on the churches. Pray that believers be salt and light in the

society and that they devise spiritually creative means to witness to nominal Christians and unbelievers. Pray for unity, passion, inspiration and power for the Church to reach out to the vast number of unreached peoples of Jordan.

Tues. Nov. 10: Greece — The first evangelised European country, now has less than 3% of the population attending church. Pray for spiritual renewal and reformation within the Greek Orthodox Church and for unity of the spirit and purpose among others. Pray for godly leaders to guide the people to the right path of God and for burden and grace for the few believers to reach out to the least reached peoples in love.

Wed. Nov. 11: Croatia — Pray for true reconciliation among Croats and the neighbouring countries and that the Evangelicals would continue to break the boundaries with the show of God's unconditional love. Pray for all Croats to move beyond empty rituals to a living relationship with Jesus and for more trained pastors and leaders to expound the word of God accurately. Pray for the emergence of vibrant indigenous churches among the unreached groups in Croatia.

Thurs. Nov. 12: Kurd, Kurmanji Turkey — The Northern Kurds of Turkey with about 9 million people practice mainly Islam with 0.01% Christian. Pray for the firm



establishment of these few believers to trust and live abundantly in Jesus Christ. Pray for the light of Jesus Christ to shine among the Kurds in various ways to move them from having high regards for Him to accepting Him as Saviour and Lord. Pray for effective ministry through the Gospel radio.

Fri. Nov. 13: Venezuela — Pray for good relationships between expatriates and national workers in Venezuela for peaceful and meaningful cohabitation. Pull down all the spiritual forces and authorities trying to hinder the people from embracing the Gospel. Pray for Christ's revelation to them, especially to their elites for a massive harvest of souls. Pray for continuous unity and cooperation among the churches and for godly leaders to uphold biblical and moral standards.

Sat. Nov. 14: Guyana — Pray for godly leaders to influence the nominal and syncretic Afro and mixed-race Guyanese positively with sound biblical teachings and doctrines. Pray for believers to demonstrate the Gospel in unity and holy living. Pray for the spread of the Gospel among the least evangelized groups in Guyana. Finally, pray that the various Christian groups engaged in youth and medical missions would continue to yield bountiful results to God's glory.

Sun. Nov. 15: Peru — Thank God for the efforts of the Evangelicals in preaching the

Gospel in Peru and beyond. Pray for renewal of strength and spirit for the believers and for the Roman Catholics to truly know Jesus Christ and serve Him in spirit and truth. Pray that the churches would unite to prioritize discipleship, accountability and sound biblical teaching. Ask God to uplift believers to positions of political and social influence so as to confront the evil forces and promote Kingdom values in the society.

Mon. Nov. 16: Nigeria Evangelical Missions Association (NEMA) — Continue to pray that NEMA will always exhibit the leadership expected of her as the umbrella missions agency in Nigeria. Pray that the leadership will remain in tune with the Lord as they carry out His mandate precisely. Pray for all that is needful to run the operations of NEMA faithfully, efficiently and timely. Pray for safety for the members and for every department to function optimally.

Tues. Nov. 17: The Bangawa, Kebbi/Niger States — Pray that the Gospel of Jesus Christ will be widely accepted and flourish among the people of Bangawa. Pull down the strongholds of other religions prevalent among them. Ask God to unveil the deceit of other religions that the people may perceive the freedom found only in Christ. Pray against the fear of persecution among the people and ask the Holy Spirit to grant as many as desire to accept Jesus Christ the boldness and grace to do so.



Wed. Nov. 18: The Pyam, Plateau State — The Pyam are mostly Muslims; pray for breakthrough and against the stronghold of Islam upon the land and their lives. Ask God to deliver the people from the captivity of polygamy and drunkenness. Pray for passionate workers that will volunteer to reach out to the people of Pyam with the gospel of Truth and Light. Pray that the believers in the land will live godly to attract the people to faith in Christ.

Thurs. Nov. 19: The Higgi, Adamawa State

— Pray that Christians in the land would see the need to reach out to the Higgi with the Gospel before the encroachment of other religions. Pull down the power of traditional religion over the people to pave way for the Gospel. Pray for strong revival for both the indigenous and resident Christians in the land. Pray for the availability of Christian materials in their heart language.

Fri. Nov. 20: The Jilbe, Borno State — Jilbe people have 0% Evangelicals and a very few number of Christians. Pray for intercessors to 'till' the land for the penetration of the Gospel and for the increase of grace and godly living among the believers. Ask God to equip and thrust out agencies and labourers with passion and burden for this people group. Pray for emergence of a triumphant Jilbe Church.

Sat. Nov. 21: The Duguri, Bauchi/Plateau States — Uphold the few Duguri believers in prayers for grace and courage to remain focused and steadfast amidst severe persecution, isolation and opposition. Pray that the few believers will reach out to their people with the Gospel in love. Ask God to annul the activities and tensions of Islam upon the land and pray that the Christians will awaken and reach out to Duguri people before others do.

Sun. Nov. 22: The Ulani, Adamawa/Taraba States — The Ulani are all Fulfulde numbering over 8 million in Nigeria and seemingly unengaged. Pray for fervent intercessors to pull down the strongholds over the Ulani people for the penetration of the gospel of hope. Ask God to raise sacrificial labourers and agencies to engage the people with the Gospel. Pray that an indigenous Ulani Church will emerge Church.

Mon. Nov. 23: MSL Management — The Management must have right judgment with swift actions as the evil days demand redeeming the time. Ask God to grant the Management wisdom, discernment, inspiration and precision in decision making for greater Kingdom impact. Pray for grace, joy and peace for the members to maintain balance between family and ministry and to remain faithful, resilient and accountable.



Tues. Nov. 24: MSL Centre — The MSL Prayer and Mobilisation Centre project is still on course. Pray that God will raise financial partners within and outside Nigeria for the construction work. Pray that the various committees set up to supervise the project will operate in godly wisdom and favour.

Wed. Nov. 25: MSL Stakeholders — Thank God for the various ways He has been using MSL stakeholders to advance His Kingdom. Ask Him to grant them greater wisdom, resilience, strategies and unity of spirit. Pray that they experience favour and cooperation from churches and individuals to facilitate the furtherance of the Gospel. Pray for safety, sustenance and all that they need to be fruitful in service.

Thurs. Nov. 26: Mission Mobilisation — Thank God for the relentless efforts of the mission mobilisers globally and continue to pray for strength, favour and safety as they go about discharging their responsibilities. Pray for open doors and acceptance for them as they relate with churches, organisations and individuals. Ask the Lord to refresh them with grace, wisdom and strategies for mobilisation and to reward their efforts with fruitfulness.

Fri. Nov. 27: Students' Ministries in Nigeria — Using NIFES, SU and FCS as points of contact, ask the Lord to endue those working among students on various campuses with

power, courage and grace to serve Him effectively. Ask God to provide all the resources needed for the smooth running of their programmes, for open doors and for the right keys to the hearts of the students. Pray for safety in all their trips and for fruitfulness in their endeavours.

Sat. Nov. 28: Emigration and Human Trafficking — Pray that the high rate of emigration in recent times will turn out for good, serving as a means of reaching out to the unreached peoples in diaspora. Pray for protection and fruitfulness for Christian workers and others targeting migrants in different places. Pray for the cessation of human trafficking, ask God to heal and restore the victims and have spiritual encounters with those involved in this evil act. Pray for effective ways to end this menace.

Sun. Nov. 29: Unreached People Groups (UPGs)— Pray that the blood of Jesus Christ will never be shed in vain in the lives of those within these people groups. Pray for the increase in number of missionaries and agencies reaching out with the love of Jesus Christ to the people. Pray for God's mercy, grace and love upon them and for their transformation into God's servants that will in turn reach their own people with the good news.

Mon. Nov. 30: Nigerian Church — Thank God for the sparks of revival among the



churches nationwide and pray that it is sustained and increased by the Holy Spirit. Ask the Lord to increase His burden of the Great Commission on the Nigerian Church for her to identify fully with missions and missionaries through prayer, financial and material support. Pull down the obstacles against the Church and ask God to make her a passionate sending mission force to the unreached world.

DECEMBER

Tue. Dec. 01: Nigeria — Thank God for His sustenance and grace upon Nigeria and Nigerians during COVID-19 challenge. The pandemic threw the nations' economy off balance and brought some precarious situations. Thank God for His intervention in the restoration of Nigeria in all ramifications. Pray for wisdom, knowledge and right decisions for all the leaders in their quest to reposition the nation completely. Ask God to uproot corruption in our systems and transform the lives of the citizens for good.

Wed. Dec. 02: Guinea Bissau — Pray that the Church would continue to lead in showing practical love and compassion and in encouraging peace and reconciliation in the country. Pray for the fulfilment of the Evangelicals' vision to multiply well-trained and equipped indigenous workers for effective mission among the Unreached in the land. Ask God to grant the Christian workers in the land grace, safety, good health and resources commensurate for the tasks.

Thurs. Dec. 03: Seychelles — Pray for revival and transformation for the Church in Seychelles and for unity, synergy and burden for the churches to engage in mission among the least reached peoples instructively and successfully. Pray that believers will reach out to the Buddhist, Hindu and Muslim communities in love. Pray for the availability of Bibles and other resources for effective transformation among the people.

Fri. Dec. 04: Equatorial Guinea — Pray that believers who have been trained for discipleship making will use their gifts and training to engage in strategic evangelism in the nation and also disciple believers. Ask the Lord to move the expatriate believers to engage with the spiritual and physical needs of the people. Pray for the laity to grow in faith and move from animistic to biblical worldviews and for the emergence of viable churches among the Unreached in the land.

Sat. Dec. 05: Benin Republic — Pray that believers will maximize the existing freedom to evangelise the people. Ask God to raise more pastors and leaders as agents of transformation in the land and to fulfil the vision of seeing every region reached and churches planted among every people group in Benin. Pray that biblical standards will override syncretism and nominalism in Benin Church.

Sun. Dec. 06: Niger Republic —Pray for the emergence of a critical mass of Christians that



would result to larger people movements to Christ in the land. Pray for result oriented literacy programmes and oral means of discipleship and teaching the Bible and for the establishment of Christian fellowship centres. Pray for unity among the churches and for effective ways to train more pastors and leaders.

Mon. Dec. 07: Tunisia — Pray that the Holy Spirit will work through the people and the land and orchestrate a vibrant Church to emerge in Tunisia again and for Christians to maximise the open doors and other opportunities to share the Gospel. Pray for government to recognise the Tunisian Church officially and to return all her properties. Ask God to raise workers for effective pastoring, mentoring, evangelism and discipleship in Tunisia.

Tues. Dec. 08: Angola — Pray for the healing, forgiveness, reconciliation, unity and expression of practical Christianity within the Church in order to attract non-Christians to the Gospel. Pray for churches to increase their involvement in evangelising and discipleship of children and youths. Pray for godly leaders, teachers and adequate resources for ministers to provide holistic ministry in Angola.

Wed. Dec. 09: Wallis and Futuna, French Overseas Collectivity — Pray for a revival that would transform the Catholic Church in these islands into a truly biblical Church and

for the members, especially the leaders to have a memorable encounter with Jesus Christ. Pray that these Islanders would encounter Jesus Christ in a way that would lead many to His salvation and Lordship.

Thurs. Dec. 10: Belize, North America — Pray against nominalism and syncretism pervading the Belize Church and for revival to awaken the members from complacency to practical Christianity. Pray for strategic ways of presenting the Gospel to birth Biblical churches among the people. Pray for oneness and unity of purpose among the multi-dialect believers in churches.

Fri. Dec. 11: Dominica — Ask the Lord to reveal Himself to adherents of Catholicism that do not have a personal relationship with Jesus Christ. Pray that the Evangelical churches would continue to provide good leadership and Gospel witness among the people. Many pastors are experiencing "burnout" as they work for support due to the weak economy; ask the Lord to renew their strength. Pray that Carib Indians will find identity and fulfilment in Christ.

Sat. Dec. 12: Brazil — Pray for the Brazilian Church to be increasingly vocal and resolute against evils, such as, abortion, homosexuality, transgender and so on. Pray for unprecedented spiritual breakthrough for the citizens to turn away from these vices and for practical



Christianity to mould the lives of Christians. Pray that the unreached peoples of Yanomami, Guarani and Kaiwa would find salvation, comfort and justice in Jesus Christ.

Sun. Dec. 13: Uruguay — Ask the Lord for a radical transformation of the Uruguayan society to end secularisation among Christians. Pray that non-religious and nominal Christians will discover the spiritual dimension missing in their lives for massive conversion of souls and spiritual growth. Pray for effective mentoring and discipleship of new believers and for new strategies for evangelising the unreached groups in Uruguay meaningfully with the Gospel.

Mon. Dec. 14: French Polynesia — Pray for the spread of the Gospel and spiritual revolution in this nation with low moral standards, especially among the nominal Christians. Ask the Holy Spirit to bring the once vibrant Ma'ohi Church back to her first love and pray for revival in the Catholic churches for unity and greater cooperation among the churches. Pray for meaningful evangelisation of the unreached communities.

Tues. Dec. 15: Bhutan — Conversion to Christianity and building churches are illegal and Christians frequently lose their rights and other benefits to Buddhists. Pray for grace and sustenance for the Christians and ask God to override the injustices in Bhutan and liberate

His children. Pray for the emergence of a vital witnessing fellowship in every ethnic group. Ask the Lord to encourage and strengthen His Church to stand firm in their commitment to Jesus Christ.

Wed. Dec. 16: North Central Nigeria — Let us continue to pray against the onslaught of the enemy to destabilise this part of Nigeria mostly inhabited by Christians. Pray that the perpetrators of these evil acts will have encounters with the Lord just as Paul did, so that they may surrender to His leadership. Pray that the Christians in the zone will not be weary but awaken to stand firm and occupy for the Master.

Thurs. Dec. 17: Agape Missions — Appreciate the Lord for the role the leadership of the Ministry is playing in missions globally. Pray for freshness and renewal in all aspects as the ministry conquers new grounds for the Lord and that they will continue to yield abiding fruit for God's kingdom. Pray for sufficient resources to run the Ministry effectively and for continued protection, grace, good health, safety and renewed zeal for the staff members.

Pray that the blood of the Lamb would liberate members of other religions causing them to recognise Jesus Christ as Saviour and Lord. Pray for massive conversion of the leaders of these religions into faith in Christ.

Wed. Dec. 30: The Church in Africa — God has given the African Church all she needs to be fruitful in the completion of the Great Commission, pray that she will use the privilege to complete the race successfully. Pray against the spirit of materialism, syncretism and denominationalism, subtly and rapidly pervading the Church. Pray for fresh outpouring of the Holy Spirit upon the Church to enable her carry out God's mandate assiduously and precisely.

Thurs. Dec. 31: Pray for Yourself — Thank God for the end of the year and for guiding, providing and protecting our family members. Thank Him for depending on and helping us to intercede for the unreached world and the Church. Pray for greater grace, strength and passion to continue to uphold the nations,



tribes and peoples in prayers and for perception of other areas we can partake in


